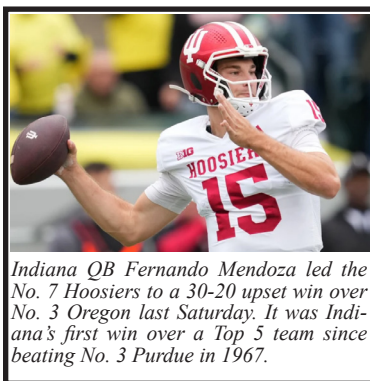

Bowling Green (+11) upset Toledo 28-23. However, Toledo had a 429-226 yard edge. Toledo led 21-0. The Rockets could have led by more at that point as they were stopped on downs at the Bowling Green 27-yard line and also the BG 2-yard line. In the second half, Toledo fumbled at their own 1-yard line which set up a BG TD "drive". BG was 0-75 dating back to 2004 when trailing by 21 points.

Tennessee (-10) beat Arkansas 34-31. However, the Razorbacks had a 496-485 yard edge and were -3 in turnovers.

Ohio State (-14.5) beat Illinois 34-16. However, Illinois had a 295-272 yard edge. Illinois was -3 in turnovers which set up three OSU TD "drives" of 35 yards or less.

SMU (-19.5) beat Stanford 34-10. However, SMU only had a 369-353 yard edge. Stanford was -2 in turnovers which included a 96-yard "Pick 6" and the Cardinal were also stopped on downs at the SMU 1-yard line.

Kansas State (+3) upset TCU 41-28. However, TCU had a 448-343 yard edge. TCU was -3 in turnovers and Kansas State scored two defensive TD's.

Minnesota (-7) beat Purdue 27-20. However, Purdue had a 456-262 yard edge. The Boilermakers were -3 in turnovers which included a "Pick 6".

Bad Beats

The total Louisiana Tech/Kennesaw State game was 47. Kennesaw led 35-7 in the final minute. Louisiana Tech ran six different plays from inside the Kennesaw 5-yard line but couldn't get a final score to put the game OVER.

Arizona (+2.5) lost to BYU 33-27 in double overtime. The Wildcats led the game 24-14 in the fourth quarter. BYU scored a TD in the final seconds to force OT.

Army (-17.5) beat Charlotte 24-7. In the fourth quarter Army missed a pair of field goals that would have given them a 27-0 lead. On their final drive, Charlotte got a TD with :08 left and the extra point gave them the 0.5-point cover.

Injuries/Personnel News

-Penn State fired James Franklin after 12 seasons. Franklin was 104-45 and led Penn State to the CFB playoff semifinals last year. Terry Smith will be the interim.

-Penn State QB Drew Allar suffered a season-ending injury against Northwestern.

-Oregon State fires head coach Trent Bray after 0-7 start.

-Texas A&M RB Le'Veon Moss (ankle) is set to miss a "significant period of time" per head coach Mike Elko.

-Texas Tech QB Behren Morton is considered "day-to-day" after leaving the Kansas game with a leg injury.

-UAB has fired Trent Dilfer and named OC Alex Mortensen as its interim coach.

-Arizona State QB Sam Leavitt is "day-to-day" after missing last week's game at Utah. According to coach Dillingham, Leavitt did move around at practice Tuesday.

-USC RB Waymond Jordan will miss the next 4-6 weeks. Backup RB Eli Sanders is out for the season with a knee injury. Walk-on RB King Miller will get the start at Notre Dame after running for 158 yards vs Michigan last week.

-South Carolina fired OL coach Lonnie Teasley. Shawn Elliott will serve as interim.

-Bowling Green QB Drew Pyne is still day-to-day according to Eddie George.

-Clemson QB Cade Klubnik (ankle) is expected to play this week.

-Michigan State QB Aidan Chiles is questionable this week.

-Notre Dame starting center Ashton Craig is out for the season.

Games in Rotation Order
Wednesday, October 15th

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Delaware 29 JACKSONVILLE STATE 28. We have Delaware power-rated as the best team in CUSA right now. However, we're not sure they should be laying a FG on the road here. Jacksonville State has a slightly better ypp margin (+0.1 vs +0.0) despite playing a similar schedule strength. Jacksonville State is also the better running team (No. 3 vs No. 83). Lean Jacksonville State.

Utah 25 SAM HOUSTON STATE 23. Can Sam Houston State get their first win of the season here? They got their first cover last week but are still falling short of expectation by 10.7 points per game. Tough laying points on the road with this UTEP offense that ranks No. 121 averaging 4.9 yards per play and can't figure out the QB position.

Thursday, October 16th

EAST CAROLINA 33 Tulsa 17. ECU is an interesting team that plays super fast but isn't that efficient offensively. They benefitted from Tulane not being able to score TD's last Thursday night in the red zone. They're taking on a Tulsa team fresh off a bye. Tulsa is the better running team (No. 76 vs No. 85) and we lean with them here.

Friday, October 17th

MIAMI, FL 33 Louisville 19. This is the type of game that Miami head coach Mario Cristobal struggles with. The Canes have had two bye weeks in the last three weeks and you wonder with a "hot" team does that impact their chemistry. Louisville had a misleading loss to Virginia in their last game. We need a "+14.5" to be involved here.

Nebraska 27 MINNESOTA 21. Nebraska ranks No. 10 in the country with a +180.7 yards per game margin. We haven't been overly impressed with their recent form. Michigan dominated them at the line of scrimmage. The Huskers had turnover and special teams luck vs Michigan State and then had to rally in the fourth quarter at Maryland last week. Minnesota did get outgained by 200 yards to Purdue last week but still won. We do prefer them playing back-to-back at home on a short week and bet them.

UTAH STATE 33 San Jose State 30. Utah State really disappointed us last week as we gave them out on our weekly shows and also to paid clients. They led Hawaii 26-24 but allowed the game's final 20 points. They're taking on a San Jose State team that led Wyoming 28-14 entering the fourth quarter but got outscored 21-0. Pass.

CALIFORNIA 28 North Carolina 19. Tough game to handicap here. Our power ratings say North Carolina is the play but you wonder how bad the locker-room is at North Carolina considering everything we've heard the last couple of weeks. NC has been non-competitive in their 3 games vs Power 4 competition. Cal has been Jekyll and Hyde all year though including leading Duke 21-7 only to lose 45-21 in their last game. We're passing.

Saturday, October 18th

Buffalo 31 MASSACHUSETTS 14. UMass is easily the worst team in the FBS after losing 42-6 to Kent State last week. The Minutemen are 1-5 ATS falling short of expectation by 13.8 points per game. That's even worse per game than 0-6 ATS Penn State. Buffalo has been disappointing this year. We don't expect to get to the window here.

APPALACHIAN STATE 29 Coastal Carolina 20. Both teams have been "up and down" so far this season. Coastal somehow is 3-3 despite getting outgained by 120 ypg (No. 128). Appalachian State did hammer Georgia State last week to get to 4-2. Coastal is the better running team (No. 70 vs No. 88).

CENTRAL FLORIDA 29 West Virginia 20. We bet UCF here. Despite a 3-3 record, UCF is +1.1 in ypp margin and also +117 in ypg margin. They could be playing with a backup QB again but nearly beat Kansas and deserved better vs Cincinnati last week as they were stopped on downs three times in Cincy territory. WVU is off a bye and could be healthier at some spots. However, they've been mostly non-competitive in Big 12 play so far.

MIAMI, OH 29 Eastern Michigan 18. Don't look now but Miami, Ohio is starting to play their best ball of the season. Their head coach Chuck Martin has always put more stock in conference games and Miami is 18-2 in their last 20 MAC games. However, we're not wild about laying 2 TD's with their offense that averages 23 ppg.

SOUTH FLORIDA 45 Florida Atlantic 26. USF is coming off an impressive 63-36 win at North Texas. The market did not buy them coming in as the Bulls were 2.5-point underdogs. They're buying now with this week's point spread. FAU is off back-to-back wins. Their offense has backdoor potential.

OHIO 27 Northern Illinois 15. Northern Illinois' offense ranks No. 135 in ypp and ppg and the main reason they are 1-5 ATS. Tough seeing them keep pace here vs an Ohio offense fresh off a bye.

Old Dominion 25 JAMES MADISON 24. Great matchup here between the two best teams in the Sun Belt. ODU is coming off the shocking 48-24 loss to Marshall as a 2-TD favorite. The Monarchs were -5 turnovers. However, they are the better team here as they have a +2.9 ypp margin (JMU +1.4) and ODU has played the much tougher schedule so far (No. 72 vs No. 133 in Sagarin).

Temple 30 CHARLOTTE 20. Temple should have upset Navy last week as they gave up a long TD run on 4th Down in the final minute. The Owls still easily covered and are 5-1 ATS this year covering by an average of 10 points per game. Charlotte got a backdoor TD vs Army in the final seconds (see page 1). This is a new role for Temple as they haven't laid doubles on the road since 2019.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN 33 Georgia State 27. Decent new rivalry here since both have joined the FBS ranks. Both teams are -1.4 in yards per play margin on the season. However, Georgia State has played the much tougher schedule (No. 40 vs No. 89 in Sagarin). That has us leaning with the dog.

Oklahoma 23 SOUTH CAROLINA 19. It was quite apparent that Oklahoma QB John Mateer wasn't healthy last week as he threw three interceptions in the 23-6 loss to Texas. South Carolina fired their OL coach which isn't great considering they are facing one of the best DL's in the country here. However, OU with a less than 100% QB, we like South Carolina here.

TOLEDO 37 Kent State 13. Jason Candle has now lost 17 times outright as a favorite since 2021. Twelve of those have come as a favorite of at least 7 points. By far the most in the nation in that time frame. Last week Toledo led rival Bowling Green 21-0. It should have been 35-0. It wasn't enough as the Rockets lost 28-23. Not sure what frame of mind, they will be in here. However, at home, they have destroyed WKU, Morgan State and Akron by an average of 50-8.

BOSTON COLLEGE 30 Connecticut 27. Boston College is reeling having lost 5 straight. The results get worse by the week as each of the last two have been in blowout fashion. They're facing a rested Connecticut team off a bye. UConn is much better in the stats but BC has played a much tougher schedule (No. 45 vs No. 143). Pass.

CLEMSON 31 Smu 21. We're not buying this SMU team. The Ponies got their first cover of the season last week but it was misleading as they got a 96-yard "Pick 6" and also stopped Stanford on downs at the 1-yard line. Clemson is off back-to-back blowout wins and playing their best ball of the season. Provided QB Klubnik is healthy, we like Clemson here and also the UNDER.

DUKE 30 Georgia Tech 29. We were expecting to get Duke with a "+" sign next to their spread. However, the market is all over this one with Duke favored over the unbeaten No. 12 team. The Blue Devils are fresh coming off a bye after they scored the game's final 38 points at Cal. Georgia Tech is better in the ypp margin (+2.0 vs +1.5). We're passing for now.

INDIANA 41 Michigan State 16. What a performance by Indiana last week as they upset Oregon on the road. It was arguably the best win in school history. The Hoosiers are up to No. 2 in our power ratings behind Ohio State. They're facing a Michigan State team off their worst performance of the season the Spartans were blown out at home by UCLA. We like the OVER if the weather stays dry.

Texas State 35 MARSHALL 31. Texas State has lost back-to-back games outright as a TD or more favorite. It's becoming very common under GJ Kinne. The Bobcats were favored in every game last year and somehow lost 5. Marshall is off a 48-24 upset of Old Dominion as a 2-TD underdog. They were +5 in turnovers. We lean Texas State.

Troy 26 UL-MONROE 22. Troy is off back-to-back OT upset wins. Now they're laying points on the road. ULM is actually better in ypp margin (-0.1 vs -0.7) and are the better running team (No. 48 vs No. 94). We think the Warhawks are live here.

Pittsburgh 33 SYRACUSE 24. Pittsburgh may have found something with true frosh QB Mason Heintschel. Last week he threw for 321 yards and led the comeback win vs Florida State on the road. We'll see if Syracuse can figure something out at QB coming off the bye.

BALL STATE 23 Akron 22. Obviously two of the worst teams in the country. Akron ranks No. 129 in ypp margin, Ball State No. 130. Our power rating is right at the number. We do lean OVER.

BOWLING GREEN 24 Central Michigan 20. Bowling Green comes in off one of the better wins in school history. The Falcons were 0-75 since 2004 when trailing by 21 points but rallied to upset arch rival Toledo 28-23. QB Lucian Anderson got the surprise start and only threw for 92 yards. As of press time, Drew Pyne is questionable. Meanwhile, Central Michigan is fresh off a bye. We like CMU here but the market is all over it.

NORTHWESTERN 24 Purdue 23. Northwestern got one of their bigger wins in recent memory last week as they upset Penn State as 20.5-point underdogs. Now at 4-2, the Wildcats are thinking bowl game. Purdue had a misleading 27-20 loss at Minnesota. The Boilers had a 456-262 yard edge but were -3 in turnovers including a late "Pick 6". We wouldn't be surprised if Purdue pulled the upset.

Lsu 24 VANDERBILT 23. Our records only go back to 1976 and Vanderbilt has never been favored over LSU. In fact, Vanderbilt has never been less than a TD underdog vs the Tigers in that time frame. The Commodores are much better in ypp margin (+2.5 vs +1.1) but LSU has played the tougher schedule (No. 9 vs No. 67). Will be interesting to see how Vanderbilt handles being a favorite in any SEC game for the first time in 52 games!

COLORADO STATE 27 Hawaii 26. Colorado State picked up a very surprising 49-21 upset of Fresno State. Safe to say, it was misleading as the Rams were +4 in turnovers and stopped Fresno on downs three times while in CSU territory. Hawaii surprised us by scoring the game's final 20 points in a 44-26 upset of Utah State. They're not the same team away from the Islands but our ratings lean with them here.

BOISE STATE 37 UNLV 24. UNLV is undefeated but has been fortunate in recent weeks. They rallied from 2 TD's down at Miami, Ohio. They got a pair of blocked punt TD's vs Wyoming and then beat Air Force 51-48 in a thriller last week. Boise State will be by far their toughest test so far. The Broncos have covered 5 straight games since losing to USF in the opener. Make it 6.

NEW MEXICO 29 Nevada 19. New Mexico has been much better than expected this season as we've upgraded their power rating 9 points (Texas Tech is the only team we've upgraded more). However, Nevada is desperate and off a bye. We're more interested in the running dog (No. 72 vs No. 93 in rush offense).

UCLA 27 Maryland 26. UCLA has been a completely different team the last two weeks with Jerry Neuheisel calling plays. After UCLA pulled off the biggest upset of the season vs Penn State, they destroyed Michigan State 38-13 as TD underdogs. Now they're playing with expectations as a favorite vs a Maryland team that nearly upset both Washington and Nebraska in recent weeks. We bet Maryland.

MICHIGAN 28 Washington 22. We don't like what we've seen from Michigan. Particularly, when head coach Sherrone Moore is on the sidelines. You can easily argue Michigan's two best performances of the season were Central Michigan and Nebraska...it just so happens Moore was suspended for both games. Michigan got dominated at the line of scrimmage vs USC last week. Washington is better in ypp margin. We'd love the Huskies here but hate the 9am PT start.

FLORIDA 29 Mississippi State 21. You have to wonder is the end is coming for Billy Napier at Florida. You thought the Gators would continue momentum after upsetting Texas. However, the Aggies controlled the second half and won by 17 last week. Mississippi State comes in fresh off a bye. Our power ratings lean Florida but the spot says Mississippi State. We haven't bet it yet.

NORTH TEXAS 34 Utsa 31. UTSA comes in off their best performance of the season as they destroyed Rice 61-13. North Texas comes in off their worst performance of the season as they got crushed by USF 63-36. We bet some UTSA early in the week.

Missouri 23 AUBURN 22. Sooner or later, you have to think Auburn is going to wave the white flag on Hugh Freeze. The Tigers led Georgia 10-0 last week. They were going in to make it 17-0 but fumbled at the goal line (controversial review) and would let that momentum dictate the rest of the game as Georgia beat them 20-10. Missouri has been much better than expected and could have upset Alabama last week. Early week market like Missouri here. A loss might end it for Hugh.

HOUSTON 24 Arizona 23. Arizona backers last week deserved better. The Wildcats led BYU 24-14 in the fourth quarter. However, BYU tied the game in the final seconds and Arizona "+2.5" tickets would die in the second overtime. Houston got a win and cover over hapless Oklahoma State. Arizona is better in ypp margin (+1.7 vs +1.0). Our power ratings made this game Houston by 1. Pass.

TCU 34 Baylor 30. Baylor comes in off the bye. Both teams are +1.0 in ypp margin and TCU has played the slightly tougher schedule (No. 27 vs No. 47 in Sagarin). The Horned Frogs got beat 41-28 to Kansas State last week but it was a misleading final as the Wildcats got two defensive TD's. We bet TCU.

Southern Miss 28 UL-LAFAYETTE 25. Southern Miss backers got back-doored last week in their 38-35 win over Georgia Southern. ULL backers got a comfortable cover. ULL is the better running team (No. 41 vs No. 80). We normally bet against Southern Miss but don't think their spread is inflated this week.

TULANE 29 Army 19. Army crushed Tulane in the AAC Championship game last year so it will be interesting to see if head coach Sumrall has a better plan to defend the option. The Green Wave couldn't convert in the red zone last week but still came away with a 26-19 win. Army backers suffered a bad beat (see page 1). We lean OVER.

GEORGIA 30 Ole Miss 22. Georgia has revenge for Ole Miss embarrassing them last year. Speaking of embarrassing, Ole Miss nearly suffered one of the biggest upsets in recent memory last week. They had to rally vs Washington State as 33-point favorites. They'll play much better here but we don't think it'll be enough.

Texas A&M 35 ARKANSAS 26. We've been super impressed with Texas A&M this year. Last week was arguably their best performance as they easily controlled matters vs Florida in the final 2.5 quarters. Arkansas played Tennessee well in Bobby Petrino's first game as interim. Will that bump continue into this week's game? The market thinks so.

IOWA 20 Penn State 17. Obviously, one of the most shocking firings in CFB history. One year after leading his team to the semifinals. Three weeks after having his team ranked No. 3 in the nation, James Franklin is out at Penn State after 12 years. Penn State is 0-6 ATS failing to cover by 13.0 points per game. Their starting QB is out for the season. Iowa is off their best performance of the season. We bet Iowa.

Cincinnati 38 OKLAHOMA STATE 17. Oklahoma State is the worst Power 4 team in the country. They're 1-5 ATS failing to cover by 12 points per game and No. 135 in ypp margin at -2.2. Cincinnati is No. 10 at +2.5 in ypp margin. Bearcats can name their score.

Ohio State 31 WISCONSIN 7. Wisconsin got beat 37-0 last week. The end is nearing for head coach Luke Fickell. Will Ohio State want to run it up on a former player and coach? Might not matter considering how bad the Badgers have been.

Utah 26 BYU 23. Utah is 5-1 ATS covering their games by an average of 9.2 points per game and that includes the 24-point loss at home as a favorite to Texas Tech. They're playing what we think is an overrated 6-0 BYU team that got a fortunate 2OT win at Arizona last week. The Holy War has seen BYU win the last two after losing 9 straight. We think the Utes get back in the series win column here. We don't like laying the hook on the road though.

Memphis 42 UAB 22. UAB finally fired head coach Trent Dilfer and hopefully they fire anyone associated in hiring him. Memphis rolls in off the bye. We do think UAB's offense has back-door potential here.

AIR FORCE 33 Wyoming 28. Somehow Air Force is 1-5 with an offense averaging 490 yards per game and 38.3 points per game. The somehow is the worst defense in the country allowing 8.1 yards per play and 497 yards per game (both dead last). Wyoming outscored San Jose State 21-0 in the fourth quarter last week. We're not sure their offense can keep up here.

Texas Tech 30 ARIZONA STATE 23. It's looking more and more like Arizona State QB Sam Leavitt will play here. He missed last week's game and the Sun Devils lost 42-10. They're facing a juggernaut this week. Texas Tech ranks No. 1 in ypp margin (+3.4), No. 1 in ypg margin (+301.4) and No. 1 in scoring margin (+35.3). The Red Raiders are 6-0 ATS covering by 10.4 points per game. TT easy cover right? Nope.

Texas 29 KENTUCKY 16. Power ratings like Texas here after the Longhorns big win over Oklahoma. The situational spot says Kentucky coming off a bye. We move ahead to further action.

VIRGINIA 38 Washington State 20. Wazzu nearly pulled off the shocker last week, losing at Ole Miss by 3 as 33-point underdogs. Virginia is off a bye after back-to-back upset wins in OT. We bet OVER.

Oregon 38 RUTGERS 22. What frame of mind will Oregon be in after getting humbled at home by Indiana last week? The Penn State win aged horribly. Might not matter vs this Rutgers defense allowing 7.0 yards per play (No. 134). We bet OVER.

NOTRE DAME 36 USC 27. As of now, this is the last time these two teams are scheduled to play each other. ND has won 6 of the last 7. The Irish have easily won 4 straight since the 0-2 start and their much maligned defense has allowed ZERO points in the second half of the last 3 games. That will get tested here vs a USC offense that ranks No. 1 in ypp at 8.3. USC does have cluster injuries at RB.

ALABAMA 35 Tennessee 25. Third Saturday in October means we're getting this classic matchup. The Tide are playing their 4th straight ranked team and they are a bit banged up. Tennessee hasn't looked great in recent weeks with close wins over Mississippi State and Arkansas. They are the better team in the stats but Bama has played the tougher schedule. Roll Tide.

Florida State 37 STANFORD 21. Florida State has lost 3 straight games. Not sure we're wild about laying this kind of number with a late night start. Stanford had a misleading loss last week. We like

They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

Of the 4 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **LSU +2.5**.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference

Games in Rotation Order

Thursday, October 16th

Pittsburgh 23 CINCINNATI 18. Don't look now but the Steelers already lead the AFC North by 2.5 games and can get a further grip on the division with a win here. Pittsburgh's defense limited Cleveland's offense to just 3.3 yards per play last week and should have similar success here. Joe Flacco was functional in his first start at Green Bay (29 of 45 for 219 yards and 2 TD's) as the Bengals covered the big spread last week. However, this is a much more competitive point spread. We lean UNDER.

Sunday, October 19th

† **L.A. Rams 24 Jacksonville 21.** @Wembley Stadium in London, England. Jacksonville has played more NFL International games than any team with a 7-6 record while the Rams are making their first trip since 2019. Jacksonville does have a new coach in Liam Coen so it will be interesting to see if their routine is different. It's one of the better International matchups this year as the Rams come in No. 1 in ypp margin at +1.5. Jacksonville is just -0.5 in ypp margin but rank No. 14 in DVOA (advanced stat metric). Not sure we see much value.

KANSAS CITY 28 Las Vegas 17. Las Vegas comes in off their second win of the season albeit it came against the lowly Titans. The two teams set back offensive football a few decades as they combined for only 451 total yards. Not good news as the Raiders try to keep pace with a Kansas City offense that has averaged 31.7 ppg the last 3 games. The yards per play margins do not call for such a big spread as KC is +0.2 and Las Vegas is just -0.1. We lean with Las Vegas here at +12.

CLEVELAND 20 Miami 18. The Browns have been at least a 3.5-point underdog in every game so far this season. Obviously, they haven't fared well at 1-5 SU and 2-4 ATS with a -0.6 ypp margin. The offense hasn't topped 17 points in any game this year. Now they're FG favorites vs a Miami team that is coming off yet another heart-breaking loss. The Dolphins don't have trouble scoring as they've averaged 25 ppg the last 5. The problem might be internally as QB Tagovailoa called out teammates after the Chargers game and we're certainly not fans of head coach Mike McDaniel. Miami is -0.9 in ypp margin and has played a much easier schedule than Cleveland. Still tough laying points with the Browns.

New England 24 TENNESSEE 16. New England has faced one of the easiest schedules but kudos to them for taking care of business vs New Orleans as a road favorite last week. Obviously, there will be extra motivation here for head coach Mike Vrabel who was fired from the Titans. Speaking of firing, the Titans fired another head coach in Brian Callahan after starting the season 1-5. The Titans are dead last in the NFL with a -1.7 in ypp margin. The line seems inflated but again, we think you have a very motivated favorite here.

CHICAGO 25 New Orleans 21. Chicago is 3-2 after their comeback upset win over Washington on MNF. The Bears were +3 in turnovers in the game. It's been a nice 3-game run but we think the Bears are fraudulent as they are -1.0 in ypp margin this season. Meanwhile, the 1-5 Saints are just -0.5 in ypp margin. They suffered another close loss last week and we think they keep it within the number here.

MINNESOTA 22 Philadelphia 21. The Eagles come in off back-to-back losses. They were embarrassed as 7.5-point favorites in New York last Thursday. Surely, you think they get back to their winning ways here? We're not so sure as Philadelphia is -0.7 in ypp margin (No. 26). Meanwhile, Minnesota comes in fresh off a bye. The Vikings are +0.4 in ypp margin (No. 11). We call for the upset win and we really like the Vikings on a teaser.

Carolina 21 N.Y. JETS 20. Tough laying points on the road with this Carolina franchise. The Panthers are 3-0 at home and are off an upset of the Cowboys last week. RB Rico Dowdle had 183 yards rushing and 239 scrimmage yards. The problem is they are 0-3 on the road and have a pair of blowout losses. We're not sure the Jets are capable of blowing out a high school team at this point (we kid). Last week the Jets had MINUS-10 net yards passing. The fewest in any NFL game since 1998 (Ryan Leaf!). Somehow they still covered vs the Broncos in London. It is obvious Aaron Glenn is in way over his head. We lean UNDER.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

L.A. CHARGERS 26 Indianapolis 24. Good game here between two teams positioning themselves for the playoffs already. The Colts are 5-1 this season but have played one of the weakest schedules. They are +1.0 in ypp margin and survived a scare vs Arizona last week. Meanwhile, the Chargers had a dramatic win over the Dolphins after blowing a second half lead. They are +0.5 in ypp margin but are 0-3-1 ATS in their last four games. Feels like a back-and-forth game. We lean with the OVER.

DENVER 23 N.Y. Giants 17. The Giants have extra time to prep after their shocking upset over the Eagles last Thursday. Rookie RB Cam Skattebo ran for three TD's and teamed with rookie QB Jaxson Dart, they've given life to the franchise (for now). Denver is coming off the London trip where they held the Jets to just 82 yards and 1.4 yards per play but couldn't cover the spread. The Denver offense managed just 246 yards but the defense did get 9 sacks. They will try to get after the rookie here. With that being said, we lean with the Giants +7 here.

Washington 28 DALLAS 27. Both teams suffered upset losses last week. Safe to say, both need a win here or their playoff hopes start to diminish. Washington was -3 in turnovers in the MNF loss to Chicago. The Commanders are the better team in the stats with a +0.2 ypp margin while the Cowboys are -0.2 in ypp margin. They have played similar strength of schedules. We trust the Commanders to bounce back more than the Cowboys but Dallas' offense has been superb especially at home. Down to the wire.

Green Bay 24 ARIZONA 20. Coming off the bye, Green Bay got the win over Cincinnati as a 14-point favorite but failed to cover their 3rd straight game. Meanwhile, Arizona, after a 2-0 start, has lost 4 straight games all by 4 points or less. The Packers are No. 3 in the NFL with a +1.4 ypp margin. Meanwhile, Arizona is -0.3 in ypp margin. It will be interesting to see who plays QB for the Cardinals. Brissett was 27 of 44 for 320 yards and a 2-to-1 TD-to-INT ratio in the narrow loss on the road to the Colts last week. We lean with Arizona.

SAN FRANCISCO 24 Atlanta 23. The 49ers come in off the loss to Tampa Bay. San Francisco suffered another big injury as All-Pro LB Fred Warner had a serious ankle injury. The vibes are better in Atlanta as the Falcons come in off the MNF upset of Buffalo. The Falcons have played the tougher schedule than San Francisco and have a better yards per play margin (+0.9 vs +0.0). It's a tough situational spot for them on the short week and traveling but we do lean with them in a teaser.

Monday, October 20th

DETROIT 28 Tampa Bay 24. Huge game with NFC playoff implications. 4th meeting between these two in the last 3 years with the most notable being the Lions 31-23 playoff win. The Lions come in off the loss to Kansas City on SNF. Even with the loss, Detroit is +0.6 in ypp margin and ranks No. 2 in the Sagarin ratings and No. 3 in DVOA. Meanwhile, the Bucs are 5-1 and QB Baker Mayfield is starting to make his case for MVP. Tampa is +0.5 in ypp margin and ranks No. 8 in Sagarin and No. 13 in DVOA in case you're wondering why the Lions are a sizable favorite. Detroit is a bit banged up. We lean with Tampa here.

SEATTLE 23 Houston 19. A great MNF double-header here. The Texans come in off the bye. Despite the 2-3 record, we think they are a playoff contender as they are No. 7 in ypp margin, rank No. 11 in the Sagarin ratings and No. 8 in DVOA. The problem is they are facing a Seattle team that ranks No. 1 in yards per play margin at +1.5 and also rank No. 1 in DVOA. We lean Seattle especially if you can find a juiced -3.
