Each month I ask God to tell me what to write for the newsletter. This month, God is telling me to ask you, "Now what?"

Mars UP Church has been through a time of struggle and trauma. Folks were angry (some still are), many are grieving, some left our fellowship (some have returned, thanks be to God!). Of those who remain, many are faithful in leadership, worship, and participation. Others are not so sure: Someone told me, "There are a lot of good people at our church who are silently waiting to see what will happen."

I have spent many hours listening, receiving opinions from all sides. *Not that it matters, since this is what I am called to do*, but the process has been overwhelming. Like many of you, I often found myself emotionally, spiritually, or physically exhausted.

Mars UP truly needs to heal, and needs hope for the future.

Let me emphasize – I recognize, appreciate, and honor your emotions, your anger, your grief, your frustration, and any other feelings or opinions you might have. Whatever you feel, it is real, and it belongs to you.

Having said all that, *now what?* Do we continue to personalize things? Do we continue to blame others? Do we continue to think, if a few folks leave, our problems will go away? Whose "fault" was it, anyhow? Is it better to focus on the past, hoping things might have turned out differently?

My friends, the past is part of us, but it is just that, the past. What happened *happened*, and we need to name it and own it. If you have left our fellowship, I hope and pray you have landed somewhere else. If you are still searching, please pray about coming back – you will be welcomed. I admit there are dozens I need to meet, so if you would like to talk, please call me. Regardless of the outcome, you will be heard (and listened to!)

Very soon, we will form a Transition Team (this is NOT the Pastor Nominating Committee) to lead us through the Interim Process. Much work lies ahead, especially the process of *Coming to Terms with our History:* as a community of faith, we need to consider and take ownership of everything that has happened (not just recently, but over the past fifty years).

My brothers and sisters, *surely there is a future, and your hope will not be cut off.* How do I know this? God told me so, and he told me to tell you! But in order to move forward, we need to take the first steps – together.

I pray you will join me.






