Raymond L. Osminski, 85, lifelong resident of Verona Township passed away Monday, Jan. 7, 2008 at the Huron County Medical Care Facility.

He was born Feb. 27, 1922 in Detroit, son of the late Michael and Blanche (Humphrey) Osminski. Raymond was united in marriage to Florence M. Nugent on May 19, 1951. She preceded him in death on Aug. 1, 1985.

He graduated from Bad Axe High School Class of 1939.
