

Accepting a position on a No Limits Volleyball team is a commitment by the player and player's parents. Acceptance of the position is a dedicated time commitment athletes are expected to communicate with coaches when other commitments occur during the season that prevent them from attending practices or tournaments. Full commitment to tournaments is required to accept a national level team position.

When accepting a position on an NLV team players and parents are aware and agree to the following:

- No Limits Volleyball players, parents, and fans all represent No Limits Volleyball. It is expected that players, parents, and fans treat fellow teammates, parents, coaches, officials, each other's facilities, and communities with respect.
- Bullying in any degree or any form (physical, verbal, written or electronic means) is not tolerated.
- Athletes and parents will submit all required forms and paperwork to the head coach or Kelsey Thurman by the first practice in December. All forms can be found on the website under the forms tab.

## Forms required for all level teams:

- Parent/Player Contract
- JVA Medical Release Form (online now)
- JVA Release of Liability Form (online now)
- Athlete Master Form
- Uniform Sheet (Due at last tryout date to get uniform in time for tournaments)
- Credit Card/ Late Payment Form

## Additional forms required for National level teams:

- \*\*Can be turned in when national teams are formed in December.\*\*
  - Copy of Birth Certificate (National Athletes only)
  - AAU Membership Card (National Athletes only)

## Playing time:

- Playing time will be fair NOT EQUAL. By signing this we understand that playing time is
  determined by the coach. We may not agree with it, but it is the coach's responsibility to do
  what is best for all players and the team.
- We agree to handle all issues observing the 24-hour rule. If you have any complaints or issues concerning your player or her coach, you are expected to wait until a period of 24 hours after the practice or tournament before contacting/confronting the coach. If you feel your issue was not resolved, you may then request a meeting with the club director or master coach.

## Tournaments:

- Athletes will be on time for tournaments and will communicate with their coach if they are unable to make it or will be late.
- Parents and/or athletes will never approach a line judge, official or scorekeeper before, during or after a match. This includes no yelling about your perception of a call or the score at the table.
- Parents, cell phones, and other electronic devices are NEVER allowed at a scorer's table. Players must focus on their duties.
- We will abide by all USAV/JVA/AAU, Team, facility and Tournament Guidelines
