

## CALABOGE SKI RACE CLUB TRAINING CAMPS ATHLETE AGREEMENT

In order that all athletes understand their obligations and responsibilities as members of the CSRC Training Camps, athletes/parents are required to read, discuss, and sign this athlete agreement.

## General

- 1. The CSRC Training Camps undertake to use all reasonable resources to assist participating athletes to meet their goals and objectives. It is our intention that all participants will be treated fairly, with courtesy and respect at all times.
- 2. Athletes should realize that professional behavior and a commitment to excellence will assist the athlete in meeting their goals and reflect positively both on the individual and the team. As representatives of the Calabogie Ski Race Club we must not only strive to attain individual goals in ski racing, but also conduct ourselves in a way that reflects positively our club.

## Calabogie Ski Race Club Training Camp Rules/Code of Conduct

The athlete (parents where applicable) agrees to the following:

- 1. To observe the Skiers Responsibility Code and Ski Area Rules for each resort.
- 2. To respect team rules as set out by the coaching staff including curfew and dryland training.
- 3. Appropriate protective gear must be worn for all training, racing and at all times when sliding on snow or engaged in risky activities.
- 4. All Athletes are to behave with courtesy, respect, and always reflect the best values of CSRC (pre-training, during training, post training).
- 5. To respect and maintain a standard of tidiness in their accommodations, fitness and equipment maintenance areas, as well as in travel vehicles.
- 6. When opposite genders are in/visiting rooms, there must be a minimum of three athletes present at all times, and the room door must remain open. Athletes will refrain from visiting other athlete rooms after curfew. **One on one opposite gender visits will not be permitted during training camps.**

- 7. Refrain from the use of profane, insulting or offensive language.
- 8. Use of tobacco, cannabis, alcohol, or vaporizer (flavour, nicotine, other) by CSRC athletes while at camp, or during training, **WILL NOT BE TOLERATED**.
- 9. Use of any illegal substances by CSRC athletes at camp, during training, or at races **WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.**
- 10. Harassment or inappropriate contact by CSRC athlete (s)/members, in any form **WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AT ANY TIME**.
- 11. Illegal activity of any kind by CSRC athletes/members while participating in Training Camps activity **WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.**
- 12. To discuss grievances or problems of any nature with the Coaching staff in a timely manner.

By signing below the Athlete/Parent acknowledge that they have read and accept the program and camp terms and conditions.

It is also understood that failure to observe the rules may result in disciplinary action.

In the event of a CSRC Training Camp athlete(s) being found to be in breach of the Training Camps Program Rules or Code of Conduct the following outcomes will be enforced:

- Use of alcohol, cannabis or other illegal substances, athlete(s) will be sent home.
- Harassment of any kind, athlete(s) will be sent home.

If the offence is beyond the scope of the Coaches and Support Staff, the appropriate authorities will be notified

Behavior that is found to be in breach of the CSRC Training Camps Program code of conduct may also result in disciplinary action (including but not limited to), being sent home and/or suspension from current or future events and/or races.

Any athlete(s) sent home due to disciplinary reasons will travel at their own expense.

Calabogie Ski Race Club Training Camps staff (Coaches and Chaperones) will be responsible for all disciplinary action. All disciplinary action will be documented by the Head Coaches and passed along immediately to the CSRC Board of Directors.
