

# MOSES S. ROGERS

1896-1978

Moses S. Rogers, age 81, of 5200 Whalen Street, Elkton, passed away Tuesday evening, April 4, at Scheurer Hospital, Pigeon, following a short illness.

He was born December 12, 1896, in Gaines Township, Kent County, Michigan and moved to the Elkton area in 1910. He lived in the Elkton area for the remainder of his life.

On April 10, 1919, he and Edith Bedford were united in marriage in Elkton. Mr. Rogers was a rural mail carrier for 42 years. He retired from this position in December of 1965. He was a member of the Elkton Missionary Church, National Rural Mail Carriers' Association, and was a World War I Navy Veteran.

He is survived by his wife, Edith, one son William, of Mason; one daughter, Mrs. Orville (Jane) Yackle, Pigeon; six grandchildren and one great-granddaughter; three sisters, Mrs. Ellen Schultz, Pontiac, Mrs. Karl (Susie) Pannabecker of Orlando, Fla., and Mrs. Hugh (Florence) Skiffington, Higgins Lake.
