DESCRIPTION: Great looking and performing vintage top-of-the line Browning target recurve. No delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes. No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing. There are a few thin stress lines on the back of the bow just above the riser (see pics). A few minor scratches and scuffs on the limbs. This is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. Comes with a used but serviceable bow string.

Note: When Browning first purchased Gordon Plastics (the principal make of fiberglass for bow limbs) to enter the archery business, they branded their bows as "Deluxe Composite Bows". Some time thereafter they added a Browning archery logo. This bow has the Deluxe Composite Bow logo only.

Note: One pic of a limb looks blueish in the picture, but is actually white with some customary "yellowing" that came with age.
