Paul Gerhard Clabuesch, 88, a native of the Thumb and longtime Mount Pleasant druggist, died Monday, Dec. 11.

He was born in Gagelton on Jan. 30, 1907, the son of Herman F. and Anna K. (Domina) Clabuesch.

He was married to Marie L. Fuller on Dec. 30, 1928, and they shared 67 years together. She survives him.

Mr. Clabuesch was the owner and pharmacist of Clabuesch Drugs in Mount Pleasant for many years. He was a member of First Methodist Church, Mount Pleasant, a member of the Postal and Pere Marquette Fishing Clubs and a lifelong member of Elks and Kiwanis Clubs.

Surviving besides his wife Marie are four children, Jane Ann Conant of Mount Pleasant, Paul Frederick Clabuesch of Pontiac, Elizabeth and Gerald Loeve of Saginaw and John R. Clabuesch of Auburn Hills; six grandchildren and two sisters, Mildred Clabuesch and Ella Steade of Lansing.

One brother, Herman Clabuesch, predeceased him in 1958.

The funeral and committal service took place Thursday, Dec. 14, at Luther Manor Home, 3161 Davenport, Saginaw. Rev. Paul Owens and Rev. Miriam Bunge officiated. Interment was in Immanuel Lutheran Cemetery, Sebawaing.
