ORDINANCE NO. 9/-3

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 83-14 ESTABLISHING CHARGES AND RATES FOR SEWER SERVICE IN THE VILLAGE OF CHAPIN, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of Chapin did pass and approve Ordinance No. 83-14 (Re-enacting Ordinance No. S-4) entitled: "An Ordinance Establishing Charges and Rates for Sewer Service and Regulating the Use of Public and Private Sewers and Drains, the Installation and Connection of Building Sewers, and the Discharge of Waters and Wastes into the Public Sewer System; and Providing Penalties for Violations of Sections Thereof"; in the Village of Chapin, Morgan County, Illinois" on the June 1, 1983; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of Chapin believe it is in the best interests of the Village to promote the growth and expansion of commercial businesses within the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAPIN, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section V, Paragraph F of Ordinance No. 83-14 (Re-enacting Ordinance No. S-4) is hereby amended by adding at the end of said paragraph the following:

For commercial and institutional users (as defined and determined pursuant to Section 2 of Ordinance 83-2, as amended) there shall be no additional sewer use charge when water usage exceeds 10,000 gallons of water per month.

SECTION 2. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, by a majority vote of the corporate authorities now holding office, and approved in the manner provided by law.
