



Happy New Year fellow Yachtsmen!

We wish you all enjoyable boating adventures this rapidly approaching Summer Season. We are also enjoying bringing you new ways to improve your boating experience at Midway Marina.

New big dock configuration:

In an attempt to eliminate build up of trees and debris piling up against the walkway to the outer Main Dock we will change the 45 degree angle to a straight out walkway 90 degrees to the river flow. Floats will be attached parallel to the current to allow debris to pass through the larger spaces between floats. Pilings will not be used so whole trees can pass under the dock without obstruction. "The Bridge" as we call it will be a shorter walk than the old 45 degree angle bridge. It will also allow a longer outer dock for increased alongside docking. Another benefit of the change will be easier removal of the bridge during serious flooding conditions. All in all we expect the change will be a benefit for everyone.

More changes at Midway:

After negotiations with the State of CT, the DEEP has exchanged easements with us in order to improve our common interests of the landscape adjacent to the Rail Line at the south end of our yard. Midway has gained a row 50' wide and 600' long on each side of the Railroad tracks. On the River side of the tracks the embankment will be cut back 30' and reshaped to look more natural and increase views of the River. On the storage yard side of the tracks the plan is to level the 20' high hill to create more organized storage space.

Cabin Rental:

We have a nice one room waterfront cabin on the property for rent. There is gas heat and range, with fridge/freezer and kitchen sink. The head consists of shower and toilet. Let us know of anyone that could be interested.
