

JOSEPH J. IGNATOWSKI

1916-1990

Joseph J. Ignatowski, age 73 of Caseville, passed away Saturday, May 5, at Huron Memorial Hospital, Bad Axe following a short illness.

He was born May 31, 1916 in Passaic, New Jersey. He moved to eastern Huron County with his parents, the late Antoni and Anna (Tila) Ignatowski, while a young child.

He was united in marriage to Mary Frankowski on June 29, 1941 in Detroit.

Mr. Ignatowski was a former employee of Michigan Sugar Company, Sebawaing before moving to Detroit in his early twenties. There he learned his trade as a millwright. He retired from Chrysler Corporation on June 30, 1974 after 28 years with them.
