HUNTINGTON CITY DUMPSITE HOURS: CLOSED MONDAY, OPEN TUESDAY AT 1:00 PM – 6:00 PM, WEDNESDAY – SUNDAY 8:00 AM – 6:00 PM. PLACE ITEMS IN THE DESIGNATED AREAS.

(DUMP MAY CLOSE IF OVER FILLED) DO NOT TAKE CEMENT, BIG LOGS OR TIRES

BURN PERIOD SEPTEMBER 15 TO NOVEMBER 15
