OLD BUSINESS

- Obstacle Course signs have been measured, Amy J mocking up for DNR approval (in progress)
- Additional Electrical Campsites Duane met with Bill Meyer Electric on 7/14. While details would need to be confirmed, the plan would be to look at electrifying the rest of the "upper" loop towards the group site (the non-electric site numbers between 450-470). Two separate services would be needed, Debbie (who works for WE Energies) will check on the current services installed. It should be approx \$1000 to add a second service. We could purchase supplies, Meyer could do the terminations, etc. Rough costs based on Home Depot pricing for supplies would be \$200/site for a panel, \$250 for a feeder panel plus wiring and trenching.
- **Bob Michaels Memorial Fund** Application Deadline: May 1st to begin in 2026. Clarification that if the funds are not dispersed to applicants by the deadline, they will still be available for the year, but early applicants will get priority. We will need an application created Amy M to work on application
- Corral Expansion Corrals installs ARE COMPLETE! Footing install in progress by the DNR
- **Trail Passes** The SKMHTA is now a Wi Trail Pass vendor, with 10% of each sale going back to our club! Get your daily or annual trail passes at SKMHTA events (meetings, booth at horse fair, etc).
- Container for Storage/Supplies delivery/purchase waiting on DNR approval of placement, Duane met with DNR. Location cleared/leveled by DNR will try to get delivered by Fall Fundraiser
- **Table Purchase for club (instead of renting):** purchase 12 tables 10 6ft folding tables have been purchased, will still purchase 2 solid non-folding tables (more stable for food)
- Host Site Corral after the recent incident of a camp host's horses being crowded and knocking down
 the lower gate panel (installed by the DNR), a motion was made for the SKMHTA to purchase 4 panels
 to add an additional corral to the host camp site*
 - Mike & Barb L purchased two used 12' panels for \$150 each, offered to let club buy for this use
 Motion by Gale S, Seconded by Val T to purchase approved

NEW BUSINESS

- Role of SKMHTA President Devan L, President, will be stepping down in January due to health issues, please consider volunteering for this role or recommending someone who is a good fit!
