HOLY SCRIPTURE

OLD TESTAMENT LESSON - Genesis 15.1-6 [NRSV]

After these things the word of the Lord came to Abram in a vision, "Do not be afraid, Abram, I AM your shield; your reward shall be very great." But Abram said, "O, Lord God, what will You give me, for I continue childless, and the Heir of my house is Eliezer of Damascus?" and Abram said, "You have given me no offspring, and so a slave born in my house is to be my heir." But the word of the Lord came to him, "This man shall not be your heir; no one but your very own issue shall be your heir." {God} brought {Abram} outside and said, "Look toward the sky and count the stars, if you are able to count them" and {God} said to him, "So shall your descendants be" and he had Faith in the LORD; and the LORD reckoned it to {Abram} as righteousness.

GOSPEL LESSON - Luke 7.36-38, 44-48

One of the Pharisees asked Jesus to eat with him, and He went into the Pharisee's house and took His place at the table. And a woman in the city, who was a sinner, having learned that He was eating in the Pharisee's house, brought an alabaster jar of ointment. She stood behind Him at His feet, weeping, and began to bathe His feet with her tears and to dry them with her hair. Then she continued kissing His feet and anointing them with the ointment...And Jesus said to...Simon, "Do you see this woman? I entered your house; you gave me no water for My feet, but she has bathed My feet with her tears and dried them with her hair. You gave Me no kiss, but from the time I came in she has not stopped kissing My feet. You did not anoint My head with oil, but she has anointed My feet with ointment. Therefore, I tell you, her sins, which were many, have been forgiven; hence she has shown great love. But the one to whom little is forgiven, loves little." Then He said to her, "Your sins are forgiven." But those who were at the table with Him began to say among themselves, "Who is this who even forgives sins?" And [Jesus] said to the woman, "Your Faith has saved you; go in peace."

CONFESSION OF FAITH - The Nicene Creed

I believe in One God, the Father Almighty, Maker of Heaven and Earth, of all things visible and invisible; and in One Lord Jesus Christ, the only-begotten Son of God, begotten of the Father before all worlds; God of God, Light of Light, very God of very God; begotten, not made, being of one substance with the Father, by Whom all things were made...Who, for our salvation, came down from Heaven, and was incarnate by the Holy Spirit of the Virgin Mary and was made Man; and was crucified for us under Pontius Pilate; He suffered, died and was buried; the third day He rose again according to the Scriptures, and ascended into Heaven, and sits on the right hand of the Father; and He shall come again with Glory, to judge the living and the dead, Whose Kingdom shall have no end.
