If you would like to contribute to Australia Zoo's Conservation Project you can donate here to help the rehabilitation of Koalas at their onsite Wildlife Hospital.

Last year 833 Koalas were admitted to Australia Zoo's Wildlife Hospital, mostly from disease, dog attacks or being hit by a car. Mammal breeding season is here now, which means more Koalas are down on the ground and often have babies in their pouch! More than ever we are needing to save this national icon from extinction.
