Eugene M. Clor, 66, of East Lansing, formerly of Argyle Township, died at his daughter's residence on Saturday March 4, 2000 after a short illness. He was born May 29, 1933, in Minden City, son of the late Leo and Elizabeth (Newsom) Clor. He married Ellen Ann Walker on Dec. 28, 1962 in Plymouth. She preceded him in death Nov. 22, 1972. He was a graduate of the Minden Elementary School. He was a wheelsman on the Great Lakes Ships from 1948-1963. Was in the U.S. Navy from November 1955 to August 1957.
