

## Baldwin School Use Committee Charter

At a Special Town Meeting held on September 19, 2015 the citizens of Baldwin voted to purchase the school building. There was also an authorization to fund a renovation to space designated for future town meetings.

Some time was devoted to uses of the remaining space in the building. A consensus to establish a committee was supported. The committee is to research all viable uses of the facility. In establishing the group, the selectmen seek representation from every segment of the population. Five (5) individuals will be appointed. A brief questionnaire is required. It is posted on the town website or may be picked up at the town office. There may be a subsequent interview. *Those not selected or other interested parties are encouraged to attend any or all of the working sessions of the committee. Written ideas or comments may also be submitted at any time.*

The committee chair will be appointed by the selectmen. They reserve the right to rotate the chairmanship position depending on the stage and progress of the work. The chair will ensure discussions are conducted in a genial, inclusive and formal atmosphere. All opinions deserve respect. Monthly reports will be presented to the selectmen. The committee will meet regularly and keep minutes that will be posted on the town website. All meetings will have a period for public input and comment.

Budget money may be requested. Funds may be needed for handouts, mailings, advertisements, consultants or the like. Requests will be made through the selectmen.

The end product is a recommendation(s) for long-term use, maintenance and support for the facility. A recommendation should be in the manner that may be presented to the voters in the form of one or more warrant articles.
