

## Mrs. Glen Wakefield

1897 - 1977

Mrs. Hope (Conkey) Wakefield, 80, Kinde, died Thursday at Huron Memorial Hospital, Bad Axe, following a short illness.

She was born April 26, 1897 in Lake Township of Huron County, daughter of the late Samuel and Amanda Conkey.

Glen Wakefield and Hope Conkey were married August 19, 1919 in Huron County and lived on a farm in Meade Township since their marriage.

Mrs. Wakefield was a retired teacher of the Caseville School System, a graduate of Central Michigan University and a member of the Chandler Presbyterian Church, where she was a choir director and organist.

She was also a member of the Worthy Study Club, Pinnebog Woman's club, and a member of the A.A.U.W. of Huron County. Mrs. Wakefield was active in community affairs as a Help Line volunteer, Member of Senior Citizens and Huron County retired teachers association.

Surviving are her husband; two daughters, Mrs. Joyce O'Meara, Palos Park, Ill., and Mrs. Faith Bishop, Grand Ledge, Mi; one son, Dr. David J. Wakefield, Filion nine grandchildren and two great grandchildren; one brother, Hal Conkey, Caseville; one sister preceded her in death (Alice). At Mrs. Wakefield's request, her body has been willed to the Michigan State University College of human medicine.

A memorial service was Sunday, August 14 at the Chandler Presbyterian Church at 2:30 p.m.
