## School Climate and Safety

- The MCCPTA board and delegates unanimously passed a resolution on the rights of and protections for undocumented students.

- The sub-committee is compiling a list of resources on school climate and safety to share with PTAs.

- Met with MCPS Health Education Curriculum director, Theresa Shatzer, to share the Maryland Children's Environmental Health Advisory Council's recommendation for minimizing wifi radiation exposure. We asked that she distribute the guidelines to staff and include in the health curriculum.
- Begun an Incident Log to chronicle the gaps in network security and privacy
- Share the concept of the Incident Log with CTO Pete Cevinini, who is supportive of the project
