- GRADING POLICY:

- Six areas of course have grade
- Three areas have deadlines for completion before Final Exam
- Permitted to try one area on Final Exam if one lowest grade
- Lowest grade you earn is the grade you get

- If you earn 'A' in each area, you receive 'A' in course
- If all 'A's before deadlines
 - no Final Exam
 - make Honor Roll

- Areas in which you will receive a grade with Final Exam possible

- EXPERT ANSWERS on 5 crucial topics
 - Say 80 points in one minute for 'A'
 - 70 points for 'B'
 - 60 points for 'C'
 - 50 points for 'D'

- CLASS ANSWERS
 - Maintain x48 ratio for quarter for 'A'
 - Ratio of team points to your penalty points
 - Say answers to workbook questions to avoid penalties
 - Attend class to avoid penalties [ATTENDANCE POLICY]
 - Arrive on time to avoid penalties [ATTENDANCE POLICY]

- SAFMEDS on important facts and principles
 - See front/Say back for 1 minute
 - Speed of corrects = "hits per minute"
 - 60 up = A no matter how many misses
 - 50-59 = A if 0-3 misses
 - 40-49 = B if 0-3 misses
 - 30-39 = C if 0-3 misses
 - 20-29 = D if 0-3 misses
 - 0-19 = F
 - Number of errors or skips
 - Four = B; Five = C; Six = D; Seven = F

- Areas in which you will receive grade but NO Final Exam possible

- Computer Project
 - Take pretest & posttest on time
 - Learn or record three units on three systems
 - Turn in results and make evaluation on time

- Construction Project
 - develop examples for cognitive routines
 - develop toolkit and tip book for own future use
