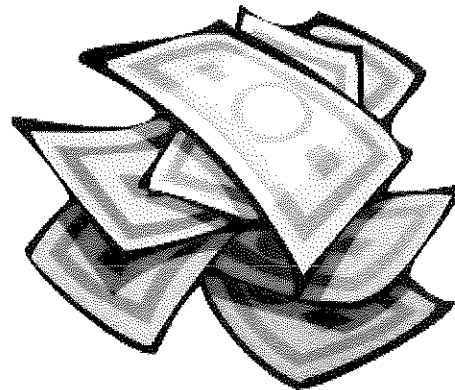
Money Earned Each Day:

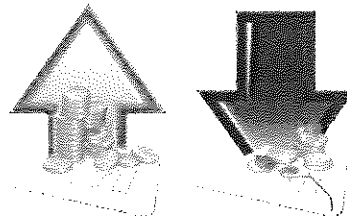

Teachers will assist students in keeping track of their debits and credits.

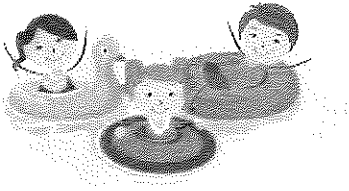
Government:

Field Trips:

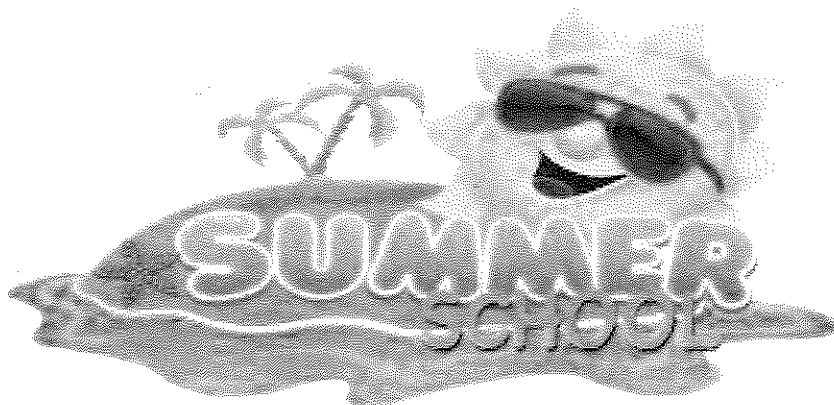
A field trip permission slip will be sent out on the first day of summer school. K-2 students will pay \$5 and grades 3-8 will be \$20 for all of the field trips and activities.
