Misleading Finals

Appalachian State (+3) beat Old Dominion 28-20. However, ODU had a 498-396 yard edge but were -3 in TO's.

Vanderbilt (+8) upset Auburn 17-7. However, Auburn had a 327-227 yard edge but were -1 in TO's and missed two FG's.

Buffalo (PK) beat Akron 41-30. However, Akron had a 452-390 yard edge but the Zips were -4 in TO's and were also stopped on downs three times.

Houston (+12.5) upset Kansas State 24-19. However, Kansas State had a 327-232 yard edge. Houston was 12 for 12 passing in the game.

Washington (+2) beat USC 26-21. However, USC had a 459-375 yard edge but were -3 in TO's. The Trojans were stopped on downs at the Washington 1-yard line, stopped on downs at the Washington 14 and also missed a FG.

Georgia Southern (+5.5) beat South Alabama 34-30. South Alabama led 30-14 entering the fourth quarter. SA had a 458-337 yard edge but were -2 in TO's.

Sam Houston (-10.5) beat Louisiana Tech 9-3. However, LT had a 312-268 yard edge but were -2 in TO's. It was the lowest scoring game of the year.

USF (-1.5) beat FAU 44-21. USF closed the game on a 30-0 run.

Syracuse (+3) beat Virginia Tech 38-31 in overtime. However, VT led 21-3.

Toledo (-10) beat Eastern Michigan 29-28. EMU did lead 19-7 in a wild fourth quarter. EMU got a 36-yard TD pass on the final play but their 2-point attempt failed.

Bad Beats

Duke (+21) led Miami, FL outright 28-17 in the third quarter. At that time, they were covering by 32 points. Miami, FL won 53-31.

The total in the Toledo/Eastern Michigan game was 54.5. EMU got a 36-yard TD pass on the final play of the game to put the game over the total.

Georgia State (+7) went 12-plays, 93 yards and got a TD with 1:47 left to lose 34-27. Some of you may have bet Georgia State at a better number and got the back-door cover.

Games in Rotation Order

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Wednesday, November 6th

Ohio 36 KENT STATE 19. The greatest time of the year is now upon us...MAcTion! Ohio comes in as a big favorite vs a Kent State team that has the worst defense in CFB allowing 541.9 ypg and 46.6 ppg. Kent State also ranks dead last in ypp margin (-2.9), ypg margin (-291.0) and scoring margin (-29.6). Ohio can name the score but we can't get to the 19.5-point spread in our ratings.

Northern Illinois 27 WESTERN MICHIGAN 26. We think NIU is the better team as the Huskies, despite playing the tougher schedule are +0.8 in ypp margin while WMU is +0.3. NIU's defense ranks No. 8 in ypp and No. 6 in total D. We would like NIU more but they've been banged up at the skill positions on offense.

Thursday, November 7th

EAST CAROLINA 32 Florida Atlantic 25. ECU does have an interim coach but still has bowl aspirations. They are the much better team in ypp (+0.7 vs -0.3). FAU was just embarrassed at home by USF and head coach Tom Herman could be on the hot seat. Our power ratings lean FAU as long as you're getting above 7.

COASTAL CAROLINA 31 Appalachian State 30. Both defenses have really struggled this year as App St ranks No. 117 in total D while Coastal is No. 116. Coastal does have the better ypp margin (-0.1 vs -0.8) and we lean with them here.

Friday, November 8th

California 30 WAKE FOREST 22. Both teams come in off a bye. Cal has four close losses this year and could have a much better record. The Bears are +0.7 in ypp margin while Wake is -0.5. Cal ranks No. 25 in total D while Wake is No. 120. We lean Cal and UNDER.

Memphis 31 RICE 22. Our power ratings like Memphis in this one. However, we don't trust their coaching staff who consistently under-performs including last week losing outright as a TD favorite vs a banged up UTSA team. Rice has an interim coach but the Owls pulled the shocker over Navy last week. Rice is better in ypp margin (+0.6 vs +0.5) and have played the tougher schedule (No. 86 vs No. 111).

Iowa 25 UCLA 20. Iowa is a fundamentally better offense with Sullivan at QB compared to McNamara. Sullivan gives you a decent run threat and Iowa is off back-to-back blowout home wins. UCLA has been playing well above expectations. They're off back-to-back outright upset road wins. The Bruins are 5-1 ATS in their last 6 and the non-cover was by a 0.5-point after they were steamed. They have played the toughest schedule in the country. Iowa games are 8-1 to the OVER this year. We haven't bet side or total.

SAN DIEGO STATE 34 New Mexico 32. New Mexico blew a 10-point late lead vs Wyoming last week and their bowl hopes took a big hit. San Diego State was blown out by Boise. Both teams are -0.2 in ypp margin and we like what both coaching staffs are doing in year one. The New Mexico offense is the best unit on the field and at 3 or more we lean with the Lobos.

Saturday, November 9th

PITTSBURGH 33 Virginia 25. Previously unbeaten Pitt was exposed last week in their loss 48-25 loss to SMU. However, they are still the far superior team to UVA who is coming off a bye after suffering three straight losses. The Panthers are +1.8 in ypp margin (UVA -0.2) and have played the more difficult schedule. We bet Pitt.

TEXAS 34 Florida 13. Keep an eye on the status of Florida QB DJ Lagway. He was carted off the field last week but it looks like his hamstring injury is less serious than originally anticipated. The Gators would be starting a 3rd-string walk-on if he can't go. Texas is off a bye and came in at No. 5 in the original CFB Playoff rankings unveiled Tuesday night. The Horns rank No. 4 in ypp, ypg and scoring margins. If Lagway can't go, this is a total blowout.

CINCINNATI 28 West Virginia 25. WVU QB Greene is likely out for this game. His replacement Marchiol has plenty of experience and led the road win over Arizona in their last game. We lean West Virginia and like the UNDER. Cincy is better in the stats (+0.3 vs -0.2) but WVU has played the slightly tougher schedule (No. 15 vs No. 29). We lean UNDER as both teams run a below average tempo.

† **Iowa State 27 Kansas 24.** Game will be played at Arrowhead Stadium as Kansas continues their stadium renovations. The Jayhawks come in off a bye and need to win out to get to bowl eligibility. They are off their two best performances of the season. The same cannot be said for Iowa State who is off their two worst performances of the season. They nearly lost outright as a 13.5-point favorite to UCF and then did lose outright as 13.5-point favorites to Texas Tech. We like Kansas but the market is all over this game.

Miami, FL 36 GEORGIA TECH 25. This game basically comes down to whether or not GT QB Haynes King plays. He's worth more than a FG to the spread and will be needed for GT to keep pace with this Miami offense. The Canes rank No. 1 in ypp, ypg and scoring offense. QB Cam Ward is the Heisman favorite but the Miami defense has allowed 34, 38, 45 and 31 points in recent weeks. We're passing for now but think GT is the sharper side.

Navy 30 SOUTH FLORIDA 28. It's been a brutal two weeks for Navy. After a 6-0 start, they were crushed by Notre Dame and then last week lose 24-10 at Rice as 13-point favorites. Can they rebound here? USF is off one of their better performances of the season as they scored the final 30 points at FAU. Their run defense has been okay and it will be interesting to see if an improved Navy pass offense can take advantage of a USF pass defense that ranks No. 132. We lean USF.

NC STATE 29 Duke 25. NC State's offense is finding its groove under freshman QB CJ Bailey. In the last 4 weeks they're averaging 33 ppg, 430 ypg and 71.5% completions. Meanwhile, the Duke defense has given up at least 400 yards in 4 of their last 5 games. Duke backers did have a bad beat last week as they led Miami 28-17 in the second half as 21-point underdogs and still couldn't cover. We lean NCSt and OVER.

Syracuse 27 BOSTON COLLEGE 26. BC comes in fresh off a bye. After a 4-1 start, they now sit at 4-4 and need a win here if they have bowl aspirations. Syracuse has already clinched a bowl thanks to their huge come-from-behind win over Virginia Tech in OT last week. The Orange trailed 21-3. BC is better in the stats (+0.0 ypp vs Cuse -0.4). However, our power ratings like Syracuse here so we haven't bet it.

JAMES MADISON 35 Georgia State 20. This is one of the better situational spots of the season. JMU comes in off a bye while Georgia State is playing their 4th straight road game. According to Collin Wilson, the previous 7 times this has occurred since 2019, the team off a bye is on a 7-0 ATS run. We bet JMU on the open but it looks like everyone else has as well.

OHIO STATE 45 Purdue 7. The Buckeyes come in off the big win at Penn State where they spotted the Nittany Lions a 10-0 early lead and controlled matters in the final three quarters. A banged up OSU OL was impressive especially on the final 11-play 58-yard drive that chewed up the final 5:13 of the game. All 11 plays were running plays. Meanwhile, Purdue is off their 2nd OT loss in 3 games. The Boilers rank No. 129 in ypg margin and No. 131 in scoring margin. The Buckeyes can name the score.

Liberty 31 MIDDLE TENNESSEE 21. Liberty is one of the most fraudulent teams in CFB this year. The Flames are 1-6 ATS and have failed to cover their games by 13.3 points per game. They have played the weakest schedule in the country and have been outright upset in each of the last two games. However, this Middle Tennessee team is not one of our favorites as they are No. 126 in ypp margin and No. 130 in scoring margin.

Byu 22 UTAH 20. Incredibly, Utah was a 3-TD favorite in this game in the summer "Game of Year" markets. Obviously, the unbeaten Cougars have greatly overachieved and we've upgraded them double-digits. Meanwhile, preseason Big 12 favorite Utah has suffered four straight outright upsets. We will see if Utah makes another change at QB (this time to Brandon Rose). We lean with the home underdog. This could be the final Holy War for Kyle Whittingham.

Fresno State 28 AIR FORCE 16. Air Force got their first cover of the season last week albeit it was by 1-point in a 20-3 loss vs an Army team shockingly playing with their backup QB. AF is just No. 130 in ypp margin and now they face a Fresno team off an upset loss to Hawaii. We bet Fresno and the OVER.

BOISE STATE 42 Nevada 17. Boise has one day extra prep off the easy win and cover over San Diego State last Friday. Boise RB Jeanty is playing with a brace on his arm but is still getting a huge workload. Nevada has been banged up in recent weeks and has lost 3 straight. They'll lose here but can they cover? Our ratings lean with Boise.

ARIZONA STATE 28 Central Florida 26. There's a good chance that ASU RB Cam Skattebo might not play in this game. Skattebo has a combined 200 rushing attempts and receptions for a combined 1,414 yards and 13 TD's so it would be a massive loss for the offense. UCF might have finally found their QB as Dylan Rizk was 20 of 25 for 294 yards and 3 TD's last week.

Colorado 32 TEXAS TECH 29. Don't look now but the Colorado should be favored in their final 4 games and have a great shot of making the Big 12 Championship. They're off a bye and playing a Texas Tech team fresh off a huge upset of Iowa State. Colorado is +0.6 in ypp margin while Tech is -0.6. Still our numbers made this 3.

Connecticut 31 UAB 26. UAB is off their most impressive win of the season as they crushed Tulsa 59-21 as 2.5-point favorites. UConn is bowl eligible but is making their first road trip since September 14th. That's not a typo. UConn has played 6 straight home games (went 5-1). We bet OVER but prefer UAB at current.

Marshall 33 SOUTHERN MISS 21. Marshall got back-doored last week in their 28-23 win over ULM. It was their first non-cover of the season. They're playing a Southern Miss team that has an interim coach and is just playing out the season. The Golden Eagles are No. 127 in ypg margin and No. 128 in scoring margin. With that in mind, our power ratings can't get to the 2-TD spread.

Oklahoma 21 MISSOURI 20. As of Wednesday morning, this line is telling you that Missouri QB Brady Cook is unlikely to play for the Tigers. We've seen the line move 7 points from the opener at Circa. If you watched Drew Pyne play against Alabama a couple weeks ago, you might say it should move more. Meanwhile, OU is off a blowout of lowly FCS Maine. Even with a downgrade in our power ratings, we can't get to OU -3 here. Lean Mizzou.

Georgia 28 OLE MISS 27. A loss here by Ole Miss and they are out of the CFB Playoffs. HC Kiffin doesn't have the best track record in big games. However, statistically he has the superior team as Ole Miss is No. 1 in ypp margin, No. 2 in ypg margin and No. 2 in scoring margin. Georgia has played the tougher schedule (No. 5 vs No. 51). What UGA team is going to show up? QB Carson Beck has turned into a turnover machine with 10 TD's and 11 INT's in his last 5 games. Will Kirby decide to bring pressure on defense like he did vs Texas (7 sacks). Ole Miss is off a dominating offensive performance. Dart threw for 516 yards and 6 TD's while WR Jordan Watkins had a school-record 254 yards and 5 TD's. Can the Ole Miss OL hold up? Can the Ole Miss defense force turnovers? We think Ole Miss is the sharp play.

TULANE 39 Temple 14. Very quietly, Tulane is 7-2 SU and 7-2 ATS. The Green Wave are the best team in the AAC (not Army) and we think they are the 2nd best Group of 5 team right now (just ahead of UNLV). Temple has been better than we anticipated this season and come in off a bye. Our numbers like the OVER here.

South Carolina 26 VANDERBILT 21. This is a very interesting handicap. One one hand, you have Vanderbilt which is a perfect 6-0 ATS as an underdog this year with 4 outright upsets. That includes upsetting Auburn last week and getting to bowl eligibility. Speaking of upsets, South Carolina destroyed Texas A&M 44-20 last week outscoring the Aggies 24-0 to close the game. SC's defensive front is one of the very best in CFB and Vanderbilt's weakness on offense is their OL.

Texas State 29 UL-MONROE 22. Texas State has been a big disappointment this season with 4 outright upset losses already this season. Their QB Jordan McCloud was banged up in last week's game and is questionable here. Meanwhile ULM's season win total was 2.5. They've doubled it and want one more to get to bowl eligibility.

Army 31 NORTH TEXAS 28. We like North Texas quite a bit here. First, they're coming off a bye with extra time to prep for the option. Two, they're off two misleading losses where they had the yardage edge vs both Tulane and Memphis. Third, Army has not faced a single offense this season ranked higher than No. 65. North Texas' offense ranks No. 3! Finally, Army QB Daily missed last week's game vs Air Force. The Black Knights had 200 yards less than their season average. If Daily plays, he will be less than 100% and you have a good bet, if he doesn't play, you have a great bet.

TCU 37 Oklahoma State 27. Oklahoma State has been one of the biggest disappointments in CFB. The Cowboys have now lost 6 straight games (1-5 ATS) and their defense is incredibly allowing 503 ypg (No. 133). TCU has been up and down all year but is No. 29 in ypp margin while Oklahoma State is No. 122. We haven't bet side or total.

OREGON STATE 28 San Jose State 26. Oregon State has played the tougher schedule (No. 78 vs No. 127) but San Jose State is much, much better in the stats with a +1.3 ypp margin (No. 24) vs Oregon State's -0.9 (No. 116). We bet San Jose State.-

WASHINGTON STATE 43 Utah State 23. Both teams come in off a bye. Washington State has a great chance to go 11-1 this season with their only loss at Boise State and solid wins over Washington and Texas Tech. We don't think that will be good enough to get in the playoffs but it's possible if the upset continue. Utah State has been playing better as of late but is up against here. Pass.

UL-LAFAYETTE 35 Arkansas State 20. Arkansas State is one of the more fraudulent teams in the country. The Red Wolves are -1.4 in ypp margin (No. 126) despite a 5-3 record. Now they face a legit ULL team that is +1.4 in ypp margin (No. 21). We bet ULL but so did everyone else. We're leaning UNDER at current market price.

Minnesota 26 RUTGERS 20. Rutgers QB Kaliakmanis is taking on his former team. The two teams seem to be heading in opposite directions. Rutgers has lost 4 straight (0-3-1 ATS) but are coming off a bye. Meanwhile, Minnesota has won 5 straight and covered 5 straight. We're betting Minnesota right? Wrong! We think this line looks right.

OREGON 41 Maryland 15. Another impressive win for the Ducks last week in Ann Arbor as a TD run in the final minute gave them the cover 38-17 (-14.5). They did lose WR Tez Johnson to a serious injury that looks like it will cost him several games. Maryland comes in off a bye but was exposed at Minnesota in their last game. We think Oregon's defense is undervalued at bet UNDER.

INDIANA 32 Michigan 18. Indiana is having an historical season. Both in their own school records and nationally as far as what teams can do from one season to the next. We've upgraded them more than any team in the country and still can't keep up. They've covered 8 straight games by an average of 19.1 ppg. Last week they trailed MSU 10-0 after the first quarter. It was the first they had trailed by double-digits all year. They responded by scoring the game's final 47 points. Michigan was a 13.5-point favorite in this game in the summer. We know that because we bet Michigan. It will go down as our worst bet of all-time as far as CLV.

PENN STATE 31 Washington 16. How does Penn State rebound after the tough loss to Ohio State? A home night "White-out" should help. What should also help the Penn State DL facing a Washington OL that has a No. 122 pass blocking grade. Washington is making their 4th cross-country road trip in 7 weeks. They've lost the previous 3 and this atmosphere will be the toughest yet.

UTEP 23 Kennesaw State 19. UTEP should get back QB Skyler Locklear for this game. He is sorely needed as UTEP has only managed 23 points combined the last two games vs Louisiana Tech and Middle Tennessee, certainly not to be confused with the 1985 Bears as far as defenses. Kennesaw State is playing their best ball of the season. We haven't bet the game.

Jacksonville State 34 LOUISIANA TECH 24. Jacksonville State has quietly won and covered 5 straight games. They're playing a disappointing that will probably be making a coaching hire at the end of the season. Jacksonville's offense is No. 7 in ypp as RB Tre Stewart already has 15 TD's. We bet OVER.

TENNESSEE 40 Mississippi State 17. The market loved Tennessee last week. We admit it was mainly a play against a banged up Kentucky team but how can you lay a big number with this struggling Tennessee offense right now? They're averaging 23 ppg in conference play and they're laying 23.5 to 24 here? Yes, Mississippi State is the worst team in the league but they covered big numbers vs Texas, Georgia and Texas A&M.

Western Kentucky 35 NEW MEXICO STATE 16. New Mexico State ranks No. 131 in ypp margin, No. 133 in ypg margin and No. 132 in scoring margin. No surprise they rank No. 133 in our power ratings. WKU is quietly 6-1 SU and ATS since losing to Alabama in the opener. Their only loss was by 1 point at Boston College in that time period.

NOTRE DAME 34 Florida State 9. In the summer, Notre Dame was only laying 3 points in this match-up. However, FSU enters 1-8 and we've downgraded them 19 points since the start of the season. They're on pace for one of the biggest downgrades in our power ratings history. Meanwhile, ND has won 6 straight (5-1 ATS) since their shocking loss to Northern Illinois. In that time frame, ND has the largest margin of victory of any team in the country. QB Leonard is playing much better as of late (PFF grades him the No. 4 QB since Week 3). FSU has the No. 133 scoring offense in the country. ND has the No. 4 scoring defense. That does not bode well for the Noles offense.

Clemson 30 VIRGINIA TECH 23. This game lost a ton of luster from last week. Clemson lost to Louisville 33-21 as 11-point home favorites. It was Clemson's first home night loss since 2013. Meanwhile, VT saw QB Drones and RB Tuten be late scratches vs Syracuse. The Hokies still led 21-3 but blew it and lost the game in OT. Drones and Tuten are questionable here. We lean Clemson.

Alabama 29 LSU 28. LSU's defense has been prone to QB's that can run which includes last year vs Alabama with Milroe running for 155 yards on them. However, can Alabama's OL protect vs a LSU pass rush that has 26 sacks in the last 6 games? The loser of this game is likely out of the playoffs. We're a little surprised that Alabama is a FG favorite here. We lean with LSU.

Unlv 33 HAWAII 20. UNLV comes in off a bye. The Rebels are No. 19 in ypp margin despite playing the No. 66 schedule. Hawaii is off their best win of the year upsetting Fresno State on the road. They usually play their best ball on the islands. We lean OVER.

Week 11 Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game

For the past eight seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game on Wednesday. **Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 487-414-14 (54.1%) clip!** That's pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots or if there are late-week injuries. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

This year's record is 14-21 so far. Of the 2 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **Kent State +20.5**.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

In 2021, we were 224-196-5 (53.3%) vs the Circa openers with an average line value of 1.8 ppg. In 2022, we were 314-262-14 (54.5%), CLV 417-122-51 +1.65 ppg). HOME TEAM IN CAPS

BALTIMORE 28 Cincinnati 22. A rematch of a wild Baltimore 41-38 OT win a month ago. Both teams had blowout home wins last week. Baltimore is No. 1 in the NFL in YPP margin (+1.5) while Cincinnati ranks No. 10. Clearly, the Bengals are better than their 4-5 record as they've been favored in 7 of their 9 games and have lost two games outright as a 7.5-point favorite. Baltimore games are on a 8-1 run to the OVER this year. We actually lean with the UNDER especially with this total bet up 4.5 points from the opener.

Sunday, November 10th

† **N.Y. Giants 21 Carolina 17.** @Allianz Arena in Munich, Germany. Our NFL exports have been embarrassingly awful this season. This game is no exception with two of the bottom 5 teams. Carolina is No. 30 in ypp margin and No. 32 in DVOA (advanced metric rating). NYG re No. 29 in ypp margin and No. 24 in DVOA. Carolina is coming off a big upset win while the Giants came up short vs the Commanders. The money continues to come in on NYG but we can't lay a TD with this offense even against a feeble Carolina team that is 2-7 ATS on the season. This is the first time NYG has been favored all season.

Buffalo 25 INDIANAPOLIS 21. Buffalo needed a 61-yard FG with :05 left to avoid OT vs Miami last week. The Bills incredibly lead the AFC East by 4 games already. Meanwhile, the Colts 6-game ATS win streak went down last week in their 21-13 loss (+5.5) at Minnesota. Indy is -0.2 in ypp margin but has played the tougher schedule. We don't have a strong lean on this game.

Minnesota 25 Jacksonville 20. Minnesota is much better in the stats with a +0.5 ypp margin (No. 6) and No. 4 DVOA ranking vs Jacksonville's -0.4 ypp margin (No. 23) and No. 26 DVOA ranking. Jacksonville covered last week but were dominated more than the final indicated vs Philadelphia. Minnesota is 6-2 ATS this year and got a nice win and cover over Indy on SNF. Is this the game that finally gets Doug Pederson fired? Also noteworthy is that Wednesday morning it is being reported that QB Trevor Lawrence has an upper body injury and is limited. We lean with Minnesota.

WASHINGTON 24 Pittsburgh 21. Pittsburgh comes in off the bye. We feel the Steelers are a little overrated as a 6-2 team. They are -0.1 in ypp margin. Washington is off to their best start since 1996. They are incredibly 7-0-1 ATS since the opening blowout loss to the Bengals. Both teams have played bottom 5 schedules so far in terms of difficulty. We just think Washington is the superior team and at home.

Atlanta 24 NEW ORLEANS 21. The Saints have lost 7 straight games. They have also failed to cover 5 straight games and come in off an embarrassing loss to the lowly Panthers last week as TD favorites. That cost Dennis Allen his job and longtime special teams coach Darren Rizzi will be the interim. Atlanta was only a 2.5-point home favorite when the two teams met in September (Falcons won 26-24), now they're laying 4 on the road. That shows you far the Saints have fallen. We lean New Orleans and maybe their is an interim one-game bump.

KANSAS CITY 25 Denver 17. Kansas City's 14-game winning streak dating back to last year is the longest in the NFL since 2014. They have also won 8 straight games when trailing in the second half including the MNF OT win over Tampa Bay. On the other side, reality set in for the Broncos last week in their blowout loss to the Ravens. With a low total of 41.5, KC -2 seems like a good teaser option. Keep an eye on QB Mahomes who has a sore ankle.

San Francisco 28 TAMPA BAY 24. The 49ers come in off the bye. They've been favored in every game so far this season and yet sit at 4-4. The scoreboards haven't matched the box scores as the 49ers are No. 2 in ypp margin at +1.2. Tampa Bay comes in off the OT loss to the Chiefs on MNF. They have played one of the toughest schedules in the NFL so far this season and have a respectable +0.2 ypp margin. They have seen the OVER cash in 6 straight games and we lean that way along with TB.

CHICAGO 23 New England 17. It's tough trusting the Bears as this big of a favorite although they are 3-0 SU and ATS as a favorite this season. Despite playing a weak schedule, Chicago is -0.8 in ypp margin (No. 28). New England is worse at -1.3. However, NE's strength of schedule is a little tougher and the Pats have been more competitive as of late with an upset win and an OT loss the last two weeks. One of our sharpest groups to +7, but one of our favorite public NFL power ratings has value on Chicago. We're passing.

L.A. CHARGERS 24 Tennessee 16. The Chargers are 5-3 and rank No. 15 in ypp margin. Jim Harbaugh is obviously a great coach and they looked much improved especially on the defensive side. However, they have played the weakest schedule in the NFL so far this season. Tennessee has been a total mess this season at 1-7 ATS. The Titans won last week in OT, but were playing the lowly Patriots and were laying 3.5. With a total of 39, the Chargers are a great teaser option down to -1.5. Chargers games are 7-1 to the UNDER.

Philadelphia 25 DALLAS 19. Just when you thought the season couldn't get any worse for the Dallas Cowboys, they lose to Atlanta 27-21 as 3-point road underdogs. More importantly they lost QB Dak Prescott to a long-term injury. Cooper Rush is expected to get the start and Trey Lance will be the backup. They're facing a 6-2 Philly team that has won 4 straight. The Eagles rank No. 3 in ypp margin (+0.8) while the Cowboys rank No. 25 (-0.7). Dallas has played the much tougher schedule. We lean Dallas at +7.5 or more even with their 1-6 ATS record.

ARIZONA 23 N.Y. Jets 22. Two of the more surprising teams this NFL season. The Jets are surprisingly bad. Even though they got a win and cover over the Texans, they're still 4 games back in the division. They do have a solid +0.5 ypp margin (No. 6). The Cardinals are surprisingly atop the NFC West at 5-4. They got an easy win and cover over the Bears yesterday. Arizona has played one of the toughest schedules in the NFL and are +0.3 in ypp. We think they are the more trust-worthy commodity here.
