The cabinet or carcass construction is fundamental to fine woodworking. With this project various joints will be made including: comb joints, various dovetails, decorative splines, half laps and mortise and tenon.

The cabinets will be made from regional solid woods chosen by the participants for their colour, grain weight and durability. They will include a drawer, shelves and a door. The cabinets will be suitable for a collection of small objects, spices, medicines or small hand tools.

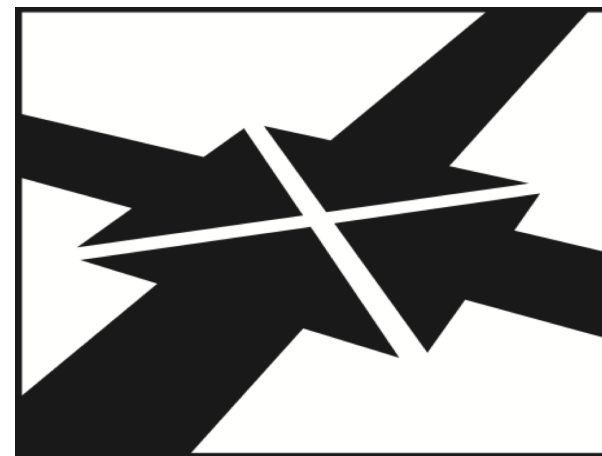
