

#### WHAT ARE THE OBJECTIVES

- \* To promote the beauty and versatility of wool fabrics and yarns.
- \* To encourage personal creativity in sewing, knitting, crocheting, spinning and weaving wool fabrics and yarns.
- \* To recognize creative skills.
- \* To develop life skills, including:
- being responsible for one's self
- being a good sport
- accepting judges' decisions
- learning about and appreciating diversity

#### **FABRIC CHOICES**

Entries may be sewn, knit, crocheted, woven or felted and must contain 100% wool or wool blend (minimum 60% wool or mohair, cashmere, alpaca, camel, llama). The ENTIRE GARMENT BODY (back, front and sleeves) must be of these fabrics. Trims, facings, linings, interfacings and underlinings may be fabrics other than wool or wool blend.

HOW CAN I BE CERTAIN MY ALL FABRICS/YARNS ARE WOOL? CONTESTANTS WOOL FABRICS MUST BE CHECK FOR PERCENTAGE OF WOOL FIBER BY OFFICIAL WOOL LABORATORY. Send 5x5 sample along with \$5 of each fabric to Dorothy Vale, 142 Carolyn Lane, Nicholasville, KY 40356 State Director for accurate analysis **BEFORE SEWING**

#### WHAT CAN I ENTER?

#### Juniors, Seniors, Adults, Made for Others

#### may enter:

- \* One-piece garment: dress; jumper; outerwear jacket, coat or cape
- \* Two-piece garment: outerwear coat,
  .jacket, cape; blouse/shirt; vest or sweater with
  dress; jumper; skirt; pants or shorts
- \* Ensemble: 3 or more garments worn together at one time: outerwear coat, jacket, cape; blouse/shirt; vest, and/or sweater with dress; jumper; skirt; pants or shorts

#### Preteens may enter:

Dress, jumper, skirt, pants, shorts, vest, sweater, shirt/blouse, jacket, or a combination of garments

#### Front, Back and Sleeves must be wool

To be eligible, a garment must have been completed after January 1, 2016

#### WHAT ARE THE JUDGING CRITERIA?

- \* Appropriateness to contestant's lifestyle
- \* Coordination of fabric/yarn with garment style and design
- \* Contestant's presentation
- \* Construction quality
- \* Creativity

Judging is private and decisions are final

#### WHO CAN ENTER?

# You must participate in the state where you are a legal residence

- \* Preteens, age 12 and under
- \* Juniors, ages 13-16
- \* Seniors, age 17-24
- \* Adults, age 25 and older (Ages on January 1, 2016)
- \* Made for Others (any age)

Anyone regardless of race, creed or sex who meets age and other guidelines may participate.

Preteens, junior, senior and adult must select, construct and model their own garments. Made for Others entries: the intended wearer must model garment.

#### KENTUCKY COMPETITION

Will be held in Burlington, KY on the morning of October 8, 2016. Entry forms are due by September 1, 2016 along with two 5x5 pieces of fabric and \$25.00.
