Upcoming W.O.W Events

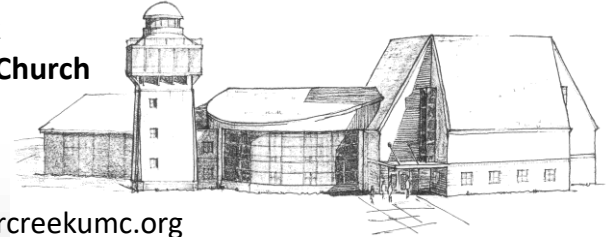
