

## **LSHOC 2022 QUILT SHOW CATEGORIES**

The show committee reserves the right to re-categorize any entry. Awards may not be given in each category depending on the quality of the entries and/or number of entries submitted.

### **Category – Definition**

**100** - Bed Quilts, Completed by one Person – 72” or greater on any side, machine or hand pieced, and machine or hand quilted. One person did ALL the work on the quilt – piecing, applique (50% or less) quilting, and binding.

**200** – Bed Quilts, Completed by two or more persons - 72” or greater on any side, machine or hand pieced, and machine or hand quilted. Two or more quilters worked on the quilt – piecing, applique (50% or less) quilting, and binding.

**300** – Bed Quilts/Appliqued – 72” or greater on any side, machine or hand quilted: machine or hand applique (must be 50% or more of the total quilt)

**400** – Wall Quilts – less than 72” on all sides, machine or hand pieced, and machine or hand quilted.

**500** – Wall Quilts /Appliqued – less than 72” on all sides, machine or hand applique (50% or more of the total quilt), machine or hand quilted.

**600** – Small quilts – less than 24” on all sides, machine or hand quilted. Any technique.

**700** – Master Quilts – Made by a Master Quilter. **Master quilter definition:** A master quilter has won 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, or 3<sup>rd</sup> place in a juried quilt show or a quilt show with 300 or more quilts in the last 5 years. A Master Quilter may enter their quilts in the Master Quilts category, Art and Modern Quilts category or Other Techniques category.

**800** – Art and Modern Quilts – any size quilt that is an original design that includes a significant amount of non-traditional techniques and /or material as a major design element. Master Quilters may enter this category.

**900** – Other techniques – any quilt that does not fit into the 100-500 categories above. This includes whole cloth quilt, crazy, embroidered, cathedral window, yo-yo, rag, etc. Master Quilters may enter this category.

**1000** – Antique Quilts – any quilt made before 1960. Non-judged category.

**2000** – Junior Quilts – any quilt made by a quilt maker age 17 or under. Non-judged category.
