Pre-registration for current RCS students: Monday, December 2nd through Friday, December 6th. Registration begins at 8am on Dec. 2nd in person as the registration forms are able to be downloaded a few days before. This is in order to make it fair for all interested parents who wanted to try to secure a spot for their child next year. We will have classes based on enrollment interest and cannot guarantee that all will be able to place their child in their first choice of class. Registration is on a first come first choice of class and is in-person only, **NOT ONLINE!** Please take a number from the table outside the double red doors and wait to be called into the Fellowship Hall once registration begins at 8am. After Dec. 2nd, if you have not registered your child yet for next year but wish to do so, please send in your registration form along with your deposit to secure your child's placement. After this we will open registration to the public as of December 9th.

Thanksgiving is a joyful time to show our RCS little ones that it is gratifying to help others and to make someone's life brighter by helping them whenever we can.
