St. Dunstan Catholic School: iPad Airls

A cart with a class set of iPad Airls was purchased for St. Dunstan School. Students in grades K-8 have been using the iPads regularly in technology literacy class. The cart is also conveniently rolled into the classrooms, where it is used to supplement the grade-level curriculum. St. Dunstan students are excited about integrating the iPads into their classwork. There are several powerful and engaging apps available to students. The Educreations app takes advantage of the built-in cameras and microphone to add an interactive dimension to the learning experience. Students are using the app to submit detailed solutions to math problems, which can be diagrammed and narrated on the iPad. The solutions are then wirelessly mirrored to the classroom projector and presented to classmates.



Cub Scout Pack 355: Pinewood Derby Storage Shed

The local Cub Scout Pack was in need of a shed to store all of its Pinewood Derby supplies. MCF provided the funds to purchase the shed and other materials such as paint. The shed is currently under construction and will soon be housing all the supplies for the always-popular Pinewood Derby!



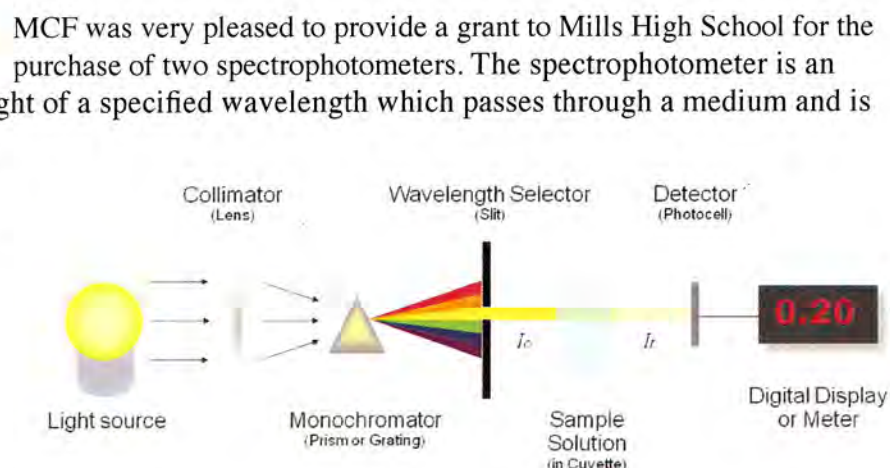
City of Millbrae Parks: Playground Equipment

Mills PTO: Spectrophotometers for Biology Classrooms

MCF was very pleased to provide a grant to Mills High School for the purchase of two spectrophotometers. The spectrophotometer is an

instrument which measures the amount of light of a specified wavelength which passes through a medium and is used for the measurement of transmittance or reflectance of solutions, transparent or opaque solids, and gases. The devices will be used in biology classrooms.
