Faith Formation

Grades 1-2nd Year, Confirmation and R.C.I.A. adapted for Children start **Sunday, September 13th at 10:00am** in-person or online. Registration for returning students has been mailed out. Registration will also take place **after Masses on August 29/30 and September 5th/6th** outside the Main Church doors.

Registration forms are available on the parish website: www.stolafut.org or you may pick one up at the parish office Mon. - Thurs. 9:00 a.m.- 3:00 p.m.

Parents/Guardians must be registered with Saint Olaf Parish to enroll their children in Faith Formation Classes. **Please register before the first class!** Due to a shortage of catechists we will not be offering a Kindergarten class and we will be combining Classes 3rd & 4th, as well as 5th & 6th.

SPECIAL NOTE

Young people who would like to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, or Confirmation are *required to have two (2) years of sacramental preparation*. Parents - If you have a child in 1st grade or 7th grade this year and desire that he/she receive the Sacrament of Eucharist in 2nd grade or Sacrament of Confirmation in the 8th grade the following year, please make sure to register them in our Saint Olaf Faith Formation Program for the 2020-2021 school year.

We ask for our entire parish family's prayers, that the Holy Spirit will guide and inspire them throughout their walks with Christ.

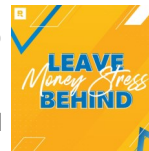
Sacred Heart Devotion
