WARREN COUNTY (PEQUEST RIVER) MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY

MINUTES

September 16, 2025

Chairwoman Napolitani called the regular meeting of the Warren County (Pequest River) Municipal Utilities Authority to order at 5:56 p.m. The meeting was held at the Authority's Administration building located at 199 Foul Rift Road, Belvidere, New Jersey.

Also, in attendance: Kim Francisco, Authority CFO; Brian Tipton, Esq., Authority Legal Counsel; John Inscho, Executive Director; and Susan Wright, Administrative Assistant.

Chairwoman Napolitani led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance and then read the Introductory Statement.

MINUTES

Mr. Roth moved, and Mr. Accetturo seconded to approve the minutes of the August 19, 2025 regular meeting, as presented. All in favor, except one abstention by Mr. Norton, motion passed.

CORRESPONDENCE

Mr. Norton recapped the correspondence listed below:

1. Letter dated August 26, 2025, from Brian Tipton, Esquire, Authority Counsel, to Allaire Healthcare Group regarding failure to make timely quarterly payments for sewerage services for their client, Warren Haven Rehabilitation & Nursing Center.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

At approximately 5:58 p.m., Chairwoman Napolitani requested to enter into an executive session to discuss personnel matters. Ms. Wright was excused during said executive session.

At 6:25 p.m., the Board returned to open session.

SERVICE AREA UPDATES

Belvidere: Mr. Roth advised the Board that at this month's Belvidere Planning Board meeting, a builder was interested in possibly re-zoning the lots on Oxford Street, which are currently zoned for 13 single family homes, to build multi-unit stacked townhomes (approximately 94 units). It was discussed; however, he is not sure if anything will come of it at this point.

Oxford: Mr. Norton had nothing new to report.

White Twp.: Ms. Skoog was not present at the meeting.

ENGINEER'S REPORT

Mr. Donati was not in attendance; however, his report was included in the agenda packets and reviewed.

CFO'S REPORT

Mr. Francisco summarized the monthly financial report.

Mr. Francisco provided the Commissioners with the FY2026 Budget Highlights.

Mr. Francisco proposed a 2.46% service fee increase. The increase would allow the Authority not to draw from reserves to satisfy operating expenses.

The Board had a discussion regarding the budget report, salaries, pensions, health insurance, maintenance, and capital improvements.

The Board agreed to move forward with the FY2026 Budget as presented by Mr. Francisco.

FINANCE

Mr. Accetturo moved that Resolution #25-31 be approved to pay all bills from the Operating Funds (Certificate No. OP 469: \$61,391.16). Mr. Roth seconded. All in favor, motion passed.

Mr. Accetturo moved that Resolution #25-32 be approved to pay all bills from the Capital Improvement Funds (Certificate No. CI 473: \$55,302.36). Mr. Norton seconded. All in favor, motion passed.

GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

Mr. Tipton reviewed the Authority's service rules and there is a section for fines and violations; however, they do not address failed payments from customers. He suggested that we create a section specifically for late payments/non-payments from customers. He will work with Ms. Wright and present something to the Board at next month's meeting.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Mr. Inscho advised that the paving has been completed at the new garage at the Belvidere plant. Spray insulator will be out this week to look at the walls and give a price. Waiting for pricing on the electric.

The pumps at the processing station are approximately 19 years old. He is looking into getting the same pump that was purchased for the pump station.

Mr. Inscho and the operators met with our Engineers at the Water Street Pump Station regarding a new rag screen system. They suggested going through the I-Bank for that project.

Pricing for the fencing for both plants will be approximately \$10,000.00.

The actuators (10) for Belvidere came in and the bill was approximately \$68,000.00.

AUTHORITY CHAIRWOMAN

Chairwoman Napolitani requested November's meeting date be changed from Tuesday, November 11, 2025, to Monday, November 17, 2025. The Board agreed.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

There was no unfinished business.

NEW BUSINESS

There was no new business.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There was no public comment.

As there was no more business to come before the Authority, Mr. Accetturo moved for the meeting to be adjourned. The meeting was adjourned at 6:52 p.m.
