- TITLE: Approval of Position Description for Natural Resources Department Program Coordinator/Biologist
- WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to Section 16 of Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984) as amended, with the Articles of Association, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 8, 1965, granting certain powers to the Summit Lake Paiute Council; and
- WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Council is the duly constituted governing body within the Summit Lake Paiute Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe is committed to the conservation of natural resources within the Summit Lake Indian Reservation and to the long-term protection, preservation and management of the Summit Lake watershed; and
- WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe has organized a Natural Resources Department consisting of staff including a Program Office Assistant to achieve these goals; and
- WHEREAS, through time, the Natural Resources Department has grown and added various programs and duties to the Program Office Assistant Position so that a new job title of Natural Resources Program Coordinator/Biologist is appropriate with an accompanying change to the job description.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Summit Lake Paiute Council hereby authorizes, approves and consents to the new Natural Resources Program Coordinator/Biologist job description.
