## The Midwest USA Junior Gold "PREVIEW" rules.


#### Abstract

Overview: This is a youth scratch bowling tournament open to any bowler age 18 and under as of August 1, 2020. The tournament will be held on Sunday, June 20, 2021 at Beaver-Vu Bowl, 1238 N. Fairfield Rd., Beavercreek (Dayton), OH. Doors open and check-in begins at 11:00 AM. Warm-ups at 11:45 AM. Tournament play begins about 12:00 PM Eastern time. There are five separate divisions. U12 boys/girls (combined), U15 boys, U15 girls, U18 boys, U18 girls. E-mails/phone calls to reserve an entry without payment will not be accepted. USBC Jr. Gold membership is not required to bowl in this tournament.

Format: The format for this tournament is the same for all divisions. Qualifying Round: All bowlers will bowl six (6) games. Championship Round: The top 4 bowlers in each division from the Qualifying Round will advance to bowl a single game, head-to-head bracketed Championship Round until a Champion is determined. Ties for advancement to the Championship Round and bracket placement will be broken by the high game rolled in the Qualifying Round. Ties in the Championship Round will be broken by a 9th/10th roll-off.

Lane Conditions: We will apply 3 different sport patterns (used at the 2019 Jr. Gold National Championships) to our synthetic lanes. A short oil pattern, a medium oil pattern and a long oil pattern. All bowlers will bowl two games on each of the 3 patterns. Cost: The pre-paid (received on or before 5:00 PM Friday, 6.18.21) entry fee is $\$ 80.00$ per bowler. Breakdown of pre-paid entry: lineage, staffing, publicity, awards: $\$ 55.00$ SMART scholarships: $\$ 25.00$. Total pre-paid entry fee: $\$ 80.00$. NOTE: The Midwest USA \$cholarship Tournaments will add $\$ 25.00$ per bowler to the total scholarships awarded (up to \$2,000.00 max.)! An entry received after 5:00 PM Friday, 6.18.21 (accepted depending on lane availability) will be classified as a "walk-in" and assessed an additional $\$ 10.00$ late processing fee. Only paid-in-full entries will be accepted. The closing date for paid entries is prior to the start of bowling.

General Rules: Appropriate apparel is expected reflecting the high caliber of bowling anticipated. Shorts/skirts may be worn provided they pass the "fingertip-length" test. All bowling equipment must meet USBC specifications. The use of powder or any foreign substance on equipment, shoes, the approach, or on the facility floor or carpet is not permitted. The bowling ball surface may only be altered prior to the start of the Qualifying and Championship Rounds. Only participating bowlers and officials are permitted in the bowling area. The bowler, by voluntary participation in the event, acquiesces to the final authority of the Tournament Manager to make necessary on-site changes and to interpret and enforce all rules, regulations, and procedures. Any unforeseen or not described situation(s) will be regulated by USBC rules with interpretative judgment guided by the best interest of youth bowling and this event. USBC Rule 400 will be observed.

Awards: The number of SMART scholarships awarded in each division will be based on the number of paid entries in each division. No fewer than 1:6 bowlers in each division will receive a SMART scholarship. 100\% of all collected scholarship funds will be awarded and sent to the SMART (\#00871).
