- Certain items can be placed in a successful compost bin. They include "greens" and "browns:"
- Greens are materials that are rich in nitrogen or protein. They are also the items that tend to heat a compost pile up.
- Browns are carbon or carbohydrate-rich materials. The main job of browns in a compost pile is to be food sources for all of the lovely soil-dwelling organisms that will work with the microbes to break down the contents of your compost pile.

TYPES OF BINS

- Open bins are easy to construct
- Closed bins, including rotating compost bins, allow you to compost without the threat of critters being attracted to your bin.

LIST OF GREENS

Grass clippings, coffee grounds, tea bags, fruit and vegetable scraps, eggshells, trimmings of perennials or annual plants





LIST OF BROWNS

 Leaves, pine needles, twigs, straw, sawdust, newspaper, cotton fabric, cardboard, dryer lint, chipped bark
