SWANK CAPS MAGICAL DAY WITH 5th TOUR VICTORY

JONES BECOMES TOUR'S NEWEST CHAMPION

JONES COLLECTS FIRST GISBT TITLE

William Jones is the tour's newest champion. The right-hander from Anoka, Minnesota grabbed the lead early in his qualifying round, and never looked back. This was the 5th match play finals appearance of his career.

He seemingly had the tournament under wraps several times, but runner-up Seth Sikkema sliced into that lead a couple of times in match play, but the champion responded each time. While his final margin of victory was just 77 pins, his triumph was actually more dominant than that appeared. The decisive factor was his sparkling 6 win and 2 loss match play ledger.

By averaging 231.06 for his 16 games, Jones reeled in the \$325 winner's check, the championship plaque, and a permanent place on Champion's Row. He becomes the 123rd different boy's champion in tour history. Congratulations, William!

3-TIME CHAMP SIKKEMA SHARP IN RUNNER-UP FINISH

Seth Sikkema was this month's runner-up finisher. The talented 2-hander from Fulton, Illinois – already a 3-time tour champion – hauled in a \$200 scholarship by virtue of his 2nd place finish. This marked the 16th match play finals of his career.

MONNENS CRANKS OUT 3rd PLACE SHOWING

Jordan Monnens earned his highest finish on tour at this month's event – a 3rd place finish that netted the 2-handed southpaw a \$175 scholarship. Monnens was appearing in the 3rd match play finals of his career.

ABOUD TAKES 4th IN TOUR DEBUT

Justin Aboud celebrated his 19th birthday in style by finishing in 4th place. The right-hander from San Jose, California made his tour debut a successful one, and he was rewarded with a \$150 scholarship.

ROTH PLACES 5th IN BEST FINISH ON TOUR

Corey Roth rolled to the highest finish of his tour career – a 5th place showing that earned him a \$125 scholarship. The Coralville, Iowa resident was making his 2nd career match play finals appearance. He was one of four 2-handers in this month's boy's finals field.

2-TIME CHAMP SOLONKA PLACES 6th

Dakota Solonka hauled in a \$110 scholarship by virtue of his 6th place finish. The 2-handed cranker from Indianapolis, Indiana was appearing in career finals #11.

DENTON EARNS 7th

Zack Denton finished 7th at this month's tour stop. The right-handed stroker from Waverly, Iowa reeled in a \$110 award by virtue of his finish; this was the 4th match play finals of his career.

GUZZLE RETURNS TO FINALS WITH 8th PLACE SHOWING

Mitchel Guzzle, from Rock Falls, Illinois, rounded out this month's boy's finals field; the right-handed stroker took home a \$100 scholarship for his 8th place finish, which was the 3rd match play finish in his tour career.

River VanVeghel, in his tour debut, rolled a 264 during his qualifying round, and that earned the Waterloo, Illinois resident a \$55 scholarship for having this month's high game out of the money.

SWANK CAPS MEMORABLE DAY WITH TOUR WIN # 5

SWANK ROLLS INTO GISBT WINNER'S CIRCLE FOR 5TH TIME

Christin Swank got hot in qualifying, and was the only player in the girl's division to average 200 for her 8 game qualifying round; she led the field by 122 pins heading into the finals. Once there, she maintained her lead, however, eventual runner-up Rachel Moore trimmed that lead to just 46 pins heading into the position round. There, the champ responded with a dominant 226-174 win, with the eventual margin of victory being 128 pins.

This was Swank's 5th trip to the GISBT Winner's Circle, but her first in more than 2 years. Her last triumph came in Waterloo back in December 2018.

TOUR VETERAN APPEARS IN 50th GISBT EVENT

This month's champion celebrated her victory in style, as this event was her 50th tour stop. The Muscatine, Iowa native was recognized in pre-tournament ceremonies for becoming just the 62nd player in the 29-season history of the GISBT to compete in 50 tournaments. Of these 62 players, Swank became just the 17th to reach 50 events in the girl's division.

This was Swank's 24th match play finals appearance, and that means she's qualified for the finals in nearly 50% of her tour starts.

MOORE MATCHES BEST EFFORT ON TOUR WITH RUNNER-UP SHOWING

Rachel Moore was this month's runner-up finisher. The 16 year-old from Keokuk, Iowa, reeled in a \$175 scholarship for her performance. Moore, appearing in the 7th match play finals of her career, matched her best effort on tour; she also finished runner-up at the 2019 Tournament of Champions.

JAROS 3rd IN MATCH PLAY DEBUT

Hannah Jaros became a first-time GISBT finalist at this month's tour event. The slender right-hander from Yorkville, Illinois was steady all day, and it led to a 3rd place finish which earned her a \$150 scholarship.

EVANS FINISHES 4th

Gabi Evans, appearing in the 5th match play finals of her career, finished 4th. The West Liberty, Iowa native hauled in a \$125 scholarship for her day's work.

3-TIME WINNER NELSON EARNS 5th

3-time tour winner and defending Bowler of the Year Addy Nelson was this month's 5th place finisher. The right-hander from Gregory, South Dakota, earned a \$110 scholarship for her efforts.

SAUNDERS 6th IN TOUR DEBUT

Jasmine Saunders enjoyed a successful tour debut. The right-hander from Keokuk, Iowa was this month's 6th place finisher, earning a \$100 scholarship for her day's work.

Sarah Fox, of Elmwood Park, Illinois, took home a \$55 award for her 224, which was the highest game out of the money.
