Contest Rules

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW. BY ENTERING THE CONTEST YOU AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING RULES.

Overview: The Increasing Independence Design Contest ("Contest"), sponsored by Access Independence Inc. ("Sponsor"), encourages designers to create a new, original 3D-printable design to produce a physical item intended to assist persons with disabilities. Two (2) eligible entrants will be selected to receive prizes based on judging of their submissions as discussed further below. By entering this Contest, or accepting a prize, you agree to comply with and be bound by these Contest Rules (the "Contest Rules").

Eligibility: To be eligible, you must be (i) at least 18 years old and have reached the age of majority in your jurisdiction of residence at the time of entry and (ii) a legal resident of the fifty (50) United States and D.C. or a foreign national in the U.S. on a valid student, travel or work visa. Void in Guam, Puerto Rico, the U.S. Virgin Islands, and other U.S. territories and possessions and where prohibited by law. Employees and their immediate family members (parents, children, siblings or spouse, regardless of where they live, or persons living in the same household, whether related or not) of Sponsor, its affiliates, divisions or subsidiaries, Sponsor's contractors, vendors, advertising and promotion agencies, or any other entity involved in the development, production, execution, administration, judging or financial support of the Contest are not eligible. Eligibility is subject to verification. The Contest is subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations, including tax laws. Winning a prize is contingent upon fulfilling all requirements set forth herein.

Prize: One (1) grand prize winner will receive a Makerbot Replicator+ 3D Printer along with factory accessories, 2x spools of Makerbot PLA filament, \$200.00 in 1.75mm eSun 3D Filament with the total Approximate Retail Value of \$2800.00 ("Grand Prize").

One (1) runner up will receive an Airwolf3D 3mm Filament Gift Basket and a 7Tech 3D Pen with a total Approximate Retail Value of \$500.00 ("Runner Up Prize").

Prize is non-transferable, and no substitution, exchange or cash redemption will be permitted, except as provided herein or at Sponsor's sole discretion. Sponsor reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. Prize must be accepted "as is," and no warranties or guarantees of any kind, including but not limited to warranties of fitness for a particular purpose, will be provided. All federal, state and/or local taxes, fees, and surcharges, if any, are the sole responsibility of the prize winner.

Entry Period: Contest runs from April 1, 2017 at 12:00 a.m. Eastern Time ("ET") through May 31, 2017 at 11:59 p.m. ET ("Entry Period"). Sponsor shall be the official timekeeper for the Contest. Late entries will not be considered.

How to Enter: During the Entry Period, upload 3D printing file(s) for your new, original product design for a physical item intended to assist persons with disabilities ("Design") through the Contest page on Sponsor's website <http://www.access3dservices.com/3d-design-contest.html> (the "Contest Page"). Each submission must include completed Official Entry Form which includes Entrant's full name, phone number and email address and other contact information, along with a brief (300-word maximum) description of the item that can be made with your Design and its purpose as it relates to persons with disabilities (each Design, together with your contact information and description, an "Entry"). Each Entry must comply with the Entry Requirements set forth below. Only Designs submitted through the Contest Page during the Entry Period will be considered. Each person making a submission ("Entrant") may submit multiple Entries, but only one entry per Entrant can win a prize in the Contest. All Entrants must be the exclusive owner of the Design being submitted, unencumbered by any license, lien, or other obligation to any third parties. Entrant is solely responsible for all equipment needed to prepare and submit an Entry, as well as all costs that may be incurred by Entrant in preparing and submitting an Entry. Entries will not be returned.

Entry Requirements: Each Entry must include a .stl or .obj file with the Design and a word document, PDF file or JPG scan of the Official Entry Form. The Design must be compatible with and capable of production by 3D printers. The Design must be for a physical item that will benefit persons with disabilities by improving quality of life, addressing disability-related barriers, or otherwise increasing independence and autonomy.

Confidential Information. By submitting an Entry, Entrant agrees that no part of your Entry, including the Design, includes any information or ideas deemed by you or by any third party to whom you owe a duty of non-disclosure, as confidential. By submitting an Entry, Entrant grants to the Sponsor the right to review and use the Entry as it sees fit,

including to share it with third party judges and service providers assisting with the Contest and to describe, display, and feature the Entry, or any part thereof, including Entrant's name, state/town, and biographical information, on Sponsor's or its affiliates' websites and in other media or promotional materials in connection with the Contest or future contests. Sponsor shall have no duty of confidentiality to you with regard to any Entry.

Entrant's Warranties: By submitting an Entry, Entrant represents and warrants that:

- Entrant is the exclusive owner of the Design being submitted and has the right to submit the Design and to grant the license and assignment granted in these Contest Rules;
- the Design is not subject to any duty of non-disclosure or confidentiality to any third party;
- the Design has not been and will not be, published, exhibited, sold or offered for sale by Entrant or any third party with the authority of Entrant;
- the Design has not been submitted to any other Contest or for consideration or commercialization by any other party;
- the Design does not violate any third party rights, including but not limited to patent rights, industrial design rights, copyrights, trademarks, rights of privacy, publicity, or any other intellectual property rights;
- the Design does not trigger any reporting or royalty or other obligations;
- the Design does not violate any applicable law, statute, ordinance, rule, or regulation;
- Entrant affirmatively represents that, in his or her good faith opinion, the Design is original and innovative. If you have already filed a patent application or been issued a patent for any part of your Entry, such information must be included with your Entry.

Without limiting any other available remedies, Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any Entry failing to meet these warranties from the Contest, or to rescind any Prize awarded to such an Entry.

Winner Selection and Notification: Two Entries from among the eligible entries received during the Entry Period will be selected to win a Prize. There will be 1 (one) Grand Prize and 1 (one) Runner Up Prize. In selecting winners, Entries will be evaluated and judged by Sponsor and a panel of judges based on factors including creativity, usefulness, originality, commercial viability, marketability, and potential impact on the lives of persons with disabilities. Decisions of Sponsor will be final and binding in all respects.

Within approximately 60 (sixty) days after the conclusion of the Entry Period, Entrants associated with the winning Entries ("Winners") will be notified via email at the email address provided with their Entry or by other method chosen by Sponsor. Except where prohibited by law, each Winner may be required to complete Prize Acceptance Documentation including an affidavit of eligibility, a liability release, and written documentation relating to assignment of intellectual property rights as required below. If winner notification or prize delivery is returned as undeliverable, or a potential Winner fails to return any required documents or releases within the specified time, the Prize may be forfeited and Sponsor may select another winner from the remaining eligible entries, in Sponsor's sole discretion. Sponsor is not responsible for undeliverable Prize notifications due to change in Winner's email address or any other reason. If a Potential Winner is disqualified for any reason, Sponsor may award the Prize to an alternate Winner from among all remaining eligible Entrants. Prize will be delivered approximately sixty (60) to ninety (90) days after winner verification.

Entrant's Assignment of Intellectual Property Rights in the Design to Sponsor. By entering the Contest, each Entrant (a) agrees to and does hereby assign to Sponsor the Entry and all rights and potential rights therein, including but not limited to the submitted Design and all inventions, patent, copyright, and design rights embodied therein, including but not limited to the right to apply for patent protection, worldwide (the "Assignment"); (b) agrees and acknowledges that Sponsor will be the sole owner of the Design and Sponsor will have the exclusive right to seek a patent for, commercialize, license and market the Design; (c) represents that Entrant has the unrestricted right to grant this Assignment; and (d) agrees to execute any and all documents necessary to legally perfect the Assignment and transfer of any and all such intellectual property rights and other rights in and to the Entry, including the Design, to Sponsor. Such documents may include but are not limited to all requisite forms and associated documents required as part of any patent, provisional patent or other intellectual property applications. If Entrant has already received issued patent(s) and/or has applied for patent protection on the Design, he or she expressly agrees to assign ownership rights in said issued patent(s) and/or patent application(s) to Sponsor in consideration of entering the Contest and the opportunity to receive a Prize. Entrant further hereby waives all "moral rights (droit moral)" now or hereafter recognized in connection with Designs submitted as part of the Contest. Notwithstanding the foregoing assignment of rights, Entrant shall retain the non-exclusive right and license to use the Design for his or her own personal or household use, and not for commercial or income-generating purposes by Entrant or any third party.

All Entrants will be considered for a potential profit-sharing commercialization of the product that is the subject of their Design. Sponsor may, but has no obligation to, develop, manufacture, produce, commercialize, or otherwise make public the Design of any Entry, including, in Sponsor's sole discretion, providing attribution to Entrant as the party who created the Design. Sponsor may, but has no obligation to, consult or seek to contract with Winners, or any Entrant, in connection with any such activities.

General: Sponsor reserves the right to cancel, suspend and/or modify the Contest, or any part thereof, or to modify these Contest Rules, for any reason at any time, including if any fraud, technical failures or any other factor beyond Sponsor's reasonable control threatens to impair the administration, integrity, legality, fairness or proper functioning of the Contest, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion. Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any Entrant, or rescind any Prize awarded to an Entrant, who is suspected or found to be tampering with the entry process or the proper administration of the Contest or to be acting in violation of these Contest Rules or any law. Entrant agrees to defend and indemnify Sponsor for any claims, losses, or damages of any kind that may be caused by Entrant's violation of these Contest Rules or breach of any of Entrant's Warranties. Incorrect, illegible, corrupt, non-functioning and incomplete Entries are void. Use of a false email or identity will disqualify an Entry. For purposes of awarding any Prize, Sponsor is entitled to rely on information received through the Entry that submitted the winning Design. By participating, each Entrant agrees to comply with, and be bound by, these Contest Rules and the decisions of Sponsor (including but not limited to eligibility and winner determinations) and waives any right to claim ambiguity in the Contest or Contest Rules. Sponsor's failure to enforce any term of these Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that or any other provision.

Privacy/Grant of Permission to use Name and other Information in Connection with the Contest and the Design. By submitting an Entry, each Entrant grants a non-exclusive, irrevocable, royalty-free right and license to Sponsor and its affiliates, parents, subsidiaries, successors, assigns, agents, employees, officers, directors and licensees ("Licensed Parties"), for the purposes of conducting and administering the Contest to store, process, use, publicly display, exhibit and publish Entrant's name, image, likeness, statements and biographical information, in connection with promoting and implementing the Contest, the Design, or future contests of a similar nature, in any media or format now known or hereafter invented, in any and all locations worldwide, without any payment to or further approval from Entrant.

General Disclaimer: To the fullest extent permitted by law, neither Sponsor nor the Licensed Parties is responsible for: (1) any incorrect or inaccurate information, whether caused by Entrant, Sponsor, any Licensed Party, or any printing or typographical errors or equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Contest; (2) technical failures of any kind including, but not limited to, malfunctions, interruptions, or disconnections in phone lines or network hardware or software; (3) unauthorized human intervention in any part of the entry process or the Contest; (4) technical or human error in the administration of the Contest or the processing or review of Entries; (5) late, lost or undeliverable messages or Entries; or (6) any injury or damage to persons or property caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, from Entrant's participation in the Contest or any Contest-related activity, or the receipt, use or misuse of any Prize.

If for any reason an Entry is confirmed to have been erroneously deleted, lost, or otherwise destroyed or corrupted, Entrant's sole remedy is another Entry in the Contest if available.

Disputes: To the fullest extent permitted by law, by entering the Contest, each Entrant agrees that: (1) any and all disputes, claims and causes of action arising out of or connected with the Contest or a prize shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, and exclusively by the state or federal courts located in Connecticut; (2) under no circumstances will any Entrant be permitted to obtain awards for, and each Entrant hereby waives all rights to claim punitive, incidental, consequential, or any other damages, court costs, or attorney's fees, other than actual out-of-pocket expense not to exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00); and (3) any and all claims, judgments, and awards shall be limited to such actual out-of-pocket costs incurred, including costs associated with entering the Contest, not to exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00). Entrant expressly waives any right to claim or recover attorney's fees or court costs. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation, and enforceability of these Contest Rules, or the rights and obligations of any Entrant and Sponsor in connection with the Contest, shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the State of Connecticut, without giving effect to any

choice of law or conflict of law rules which would cause the application of the laws of any jurisdiction other than the State of Connecticut.

Trademarks. Company names and trademarks associated with prizes are used solely to identify the prizes. No endorsement, authorization, sponsorship, or approval of prize manufacturers or trademark owners is intended or implied by such use. All referenced company names and trademarks are registered and unregistered trademarks or copyrights of their respective owners.

Severability: In the event that any provision of these Contest Rules is found to be invalid, illegal or otherwise unenforceable, such provision shall be severed, the remainder of these Contest Rules shall continue in full force and effect, and any such unenforceable provision shall be reformed to provide the maximum protection to the Sponsor permissible under law.
