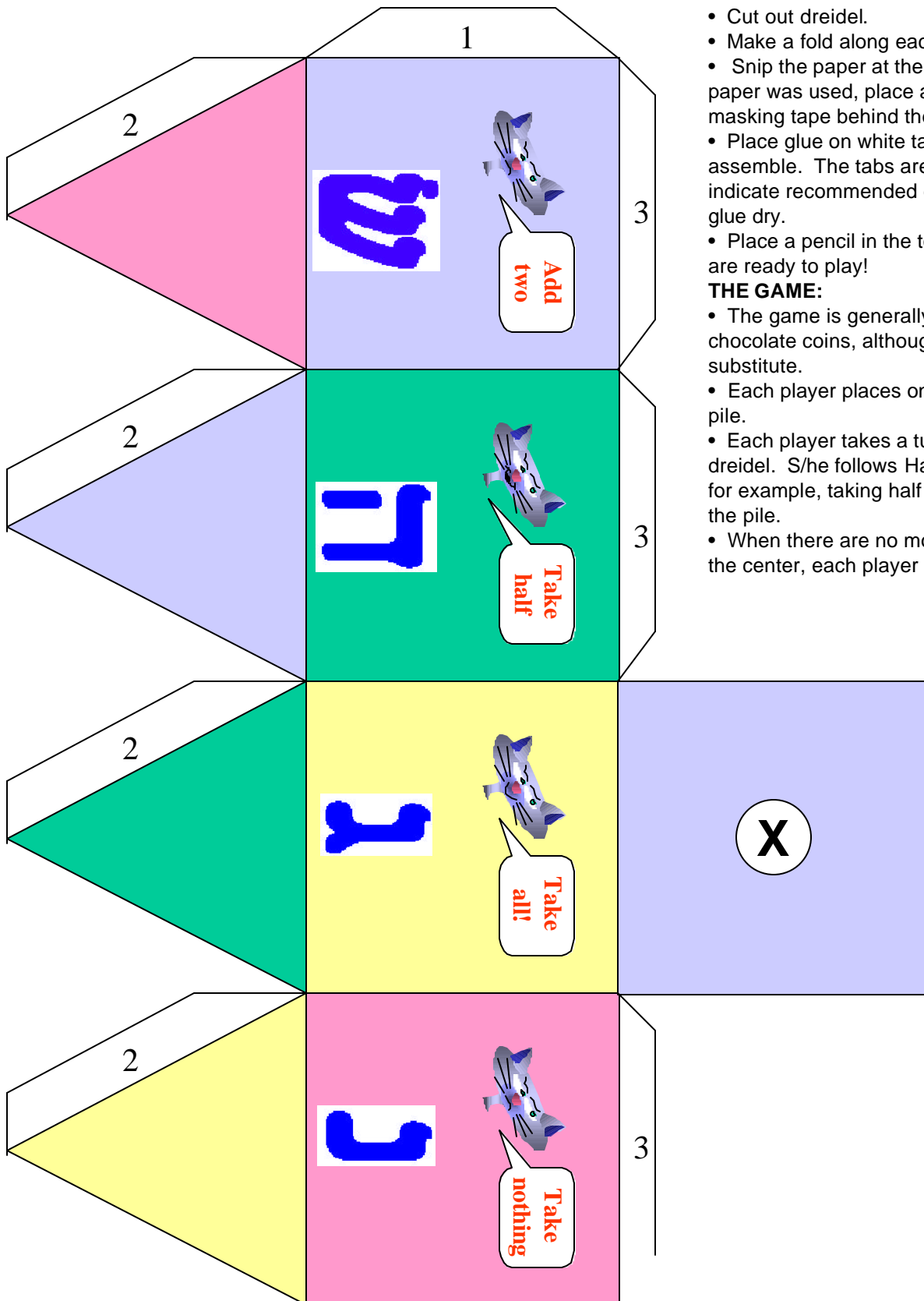


HanuKat Dreidel

- Print, preferably on a heavy paper such as card stock.
- Cut out dreidel.
- Make a fold along each black line.
- Snip the paper at the "X." If regular paper was used, place a piece of masking tape behind the "X" first.
- Place glue on white tabs and assemble. The tabs are numbered to indicate recommended gluing order. Let glue dry.
- Place a pencil in the top hole and you are ready to play!

THE GAME:

- The game is generally played using chocolate coins, although, feel free to substitute.
- Each player places one coin in a center pile.
- Each player takes a turn spinning the dreidel. S/he follows HanuKat's direction, for example, taking half the coins from the pile.
- When there are no more coins left in the center, each player adds in another.
