Holy Rosary in October – October is devoted to Mary and to the praying of the Holy Rosary. Join us every Sunday at 10:30 a.m. to join in praying the rosary.

Mission Sunday is Sunday, October 8th. The day will start with 11:00 a.m. Mass followed by the SCC monthly dinner dedicated to the needs of the Slovenian missionaries. Everyone is kindly invited to bring items for the dollar raffle and a bakery sale.

All Saints Day, Wednesday, November 1st – Slovenian Mass will be held in the church at 11:00 a.m.

Advent starts December 3rd, non-perishable food will be collected in the church and in the Center for Christmas baskets for the needy in the area.

The Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary is Friday, December 8th. It is a Holy Day of Obligation. On this day we celebrate the feast day of America's patron saint, our mother Mary, in the Immaculate Conception. Slovenian Mass will be held in the church at 11:00 a.m.

Family Mass – On the 2nd Sunday of every month, all families with school children are encouraged to attend the Family Mass and actively participate with readings, petitions, and singing. After Mass, our monthly dinners are held at the Center. In December, Family Mass will take place on 'Miklavž' Sunday, December 3rd.

Christmas – Masses will be said at midnight on Christmas Eve and at 11:00 a.m. Christmas Day. The church choir will sing Christmas carols starting at 11:30 p.m. before Midnight Mass.

Holy Family Sunday, December 31st – at the 11:00 a.m. Mass there will be a blessing of the children & families.

New Year – In thanksgiving for the past and to pray for blessings in the new year, Holy Mass will be offered on New Year's Eve at 6:00 p.m. and on New Year's Day at 11:00 a.m.

SE NEWS Thanks goes out to the men who showed up to install 79 new windows in the retreat house over three weekends; which were donated by

Richards Building Supply. Thanks also goes out to Slavica Sovan and Marilyn Erman for making new curtains in the retreat house. The website for St. Mary's Retreat House lists all those who have volunteered so far to clean and renovate the house. Since March, we have put in almost 2,000 hours of volunteer labor to improve the Retreat House. That includes a crew from Brian Ruda's plumbing company who installed new water lines in the old kitchen area. They also tore out old gas and water lines that were no longer being used. We received a donation of 27 new Thera-Peutic mattresses to replace the 32 year old mattresses. We still need to replace 55 more. **Hvala Lepa to all!**
