Lyle N. Faber, 85, of Sebewaing died Thursday evening, June 15, 2000 at Hills and Dales General Hospital in Cass City following a three and a half year illness. He was born June 25, 1914 in Sebewaing Township, son of the late Theodore E. and Jessie (Dutcher) Faber. He was united in marriage to Edna Alice Fritz on April 13, 1939 in Detroit. She preceded him in death on Feb. 13, 1997. Lyle had been a farmer in the Sebewaing area for many years before retiring in 1980. He was an avid woodworker and enjoyed building clocks. He also was a mechanic and plumber. He was a lifelong member of St. Peter Lutheran Church in Bach where he held various offices.
