PRIZES

The prize pool will be averaged in case of a tie. Example: If 3 people tie for 2nd position, the prize for positions 2, 3 & 4 will be added together and divided by 3.

Pick and circle one PGA Golfer from each group above. Each golfer will earn points for every individual tournament as shown below. Points are awarded based on the official score (strokes, not position) for each golfer according to the PGA Tour website. In case of a tie, each golfer will receive the amount of points assigned for that number of strokes, except when there is a tie for first place requiring a playoff. The winner of the playoff (1st) will receive 40 points and the loser (2nd) will receive 30 points. If your golfer moves to LIV, he is no longer counted in this pool.

Winners are responsible for contacting the administrator.

Points: 1st=40pts, 2nd=30pts, 3rd=25pts, 4th=20pts, 5th=15pts, 6th=10pts, 7th=8pts, 8th=6pts, 9th=4pts, 10th=2pts.



Double points are scheduled for 5 weekends:

The Masters - April 10 thru April 13

The PGA Championship - May 15 thru May 18

The US Open - June 12 thru June 15

The British Open - Jul 17 thru Jul 20

The Tour Championship - Aug 21 thru Aug 24

Double points are NOT guaranteed and are subject to scheduling changes.

We'll count 31 tournaments from The American Express (Jan 16-19) to The Tour Championship (Aug 21-24). Only individual tournaments count. No points awarded for match play or team events. Prizes will be determined by the number of entries. We are NOT counting: Puerto Rico Open 3/6-3/9, Corales 4/17-4/20, Zurich 4/24-4/27, Myrtle Beach 5/8-5/11, ISCO Championship 7/10-7/13, Barracuda 7/17-7/20. The pool will end with the Tour Championship and will not be extended for any reason unless the date of the Tour Championship is changed, then that new date will become the new pool end date.
