Director's Report

- The NYC trip went well once every one was settled in. All student were asked to write an essay about their favorite memories of the trip and the top three appeared to be "Alladin," the Radio Center Music Hall tour, and performing at the Lincoln Center.
- Barbershop and Beautyshop auditions were held and both groups are set for next year.
- We have four students going to state choir in Tyson's Corner.

- Due to the NYC trip and spring break we have decided to wait until May to present the slate of board and committee chairs for the 2015-2016 school year.

Reports from General Board Committee Chairs

- There will be a need for cookies for the spring concert, May 17th. Sharon said she has gingerale for punch and there is a water dispenser they can use.
- Question was raised about poster night and that will be held during our meeting time next month, May 4th.

Reports from Spring Trip Fundraising Committee Chairs

- Lisa mentioned we need to decide if we are doing Premier Athletics next year and she will talk to Mr. Clatterbuck about that.

Kroger Rewards (Mia White)

- From 12/1-2/28 we raised \$1,079.
- Mia reported that we have several \$5 gift cards from past years when cards were used to raise money. She made a suggestion to bundle the cards in threes, \$15, and put it into a raffle for people who sign up for the current program. There was discussion in regards to this idea. No decision was made but something to consider since we have the \$5 dollar gift cards.
