As the year winds down and the holidays arrive, I think of the people who support our mission and empower us to continue to serve the community in the capacity that we do. I'd like to take this opportunity to share what you made possible. It's hard to put into words, but these are just some of the miracles we have experienced in 2024 because of your support.

Our Young Adult staff visited the Comal County Jail's Day Treatment Program weekly to facilitate a recovery meeting. We were able to bring laughter and hope to people in a place that isn't funny. We swam in the river and the joy of our fellowship in the sun has led our group members to realize that it is possible to enjoy life without drugs and alcohol. We get to be the people we wished we had in our lives to listen to us, see us, and show us that we are safe in this place with these other flawed people, people who make mistakes but keep trying to do better.

The Youth Staff met every week with kids at alternative school. They also began counseling onsite at SJRC. Teens met weekly for groups and counseling. They continued to show up because they have built deep supportive connections with our staff and other group members. We saw the kids show each other how to be honest and vulnerable. We showed them how to grow up, and got to see ourselves through the formation of our groups.

We got to do so many cool things at our sober social events. We went on outings and had parties. We went to outside 12-step meetings and did karaoke. We ate pizza. Youth staff recently played paintball for two hours on a Friday night.

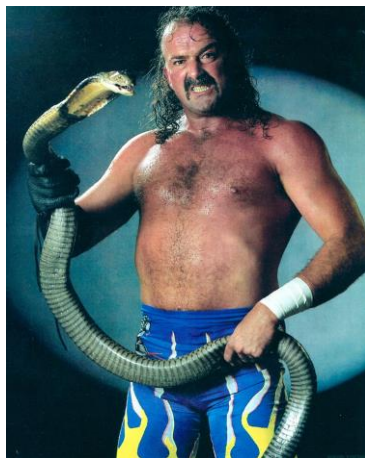
