Village Clerk Report - Heather Sherman

- Currently reading water meters.

Treasurer Report - Jessica Bonnell

Police Report - Dave Woolford

Monthly Report – 3 speeding citations, 2 disobeying stop sign citations, 1 uninsured vehicle citations and 5 verbal warnings for equipment violations.

- Repeater is fixed. The bill will be split between us Cedar Point and Lostant.
- A lot of new mandates for police training, it's been taking up a lot of time but almost caught up.

Water & Sewer/Streets & Alley Report - Marc Lemrise

- ComEd approved installing a new street light across the street from the old Casey's and turning the street light in front of Casey's so it faces Rt 251.
- Ran a camera through tile on Peru St. Tons of roots needed to be cut and removed but water is flowing again.
- Steadily working on clearing stuff out of Nursery Property. Anything salvageable will be put up for sale on a sealed bid.

Engineer's Report - Jack Kusek (absent)

- Need to make a decision on a pumphouse filter.

Attorney's Report - Robert Steele

- Heartland Cable has a small building on the village's property on 2nd St through a franchise agreement. The agreement expired in 2013 and no payments have been made since. The board agreed to look into charging rent for the use of the village's property.
