

# MASTER PLAN | VISION 2040

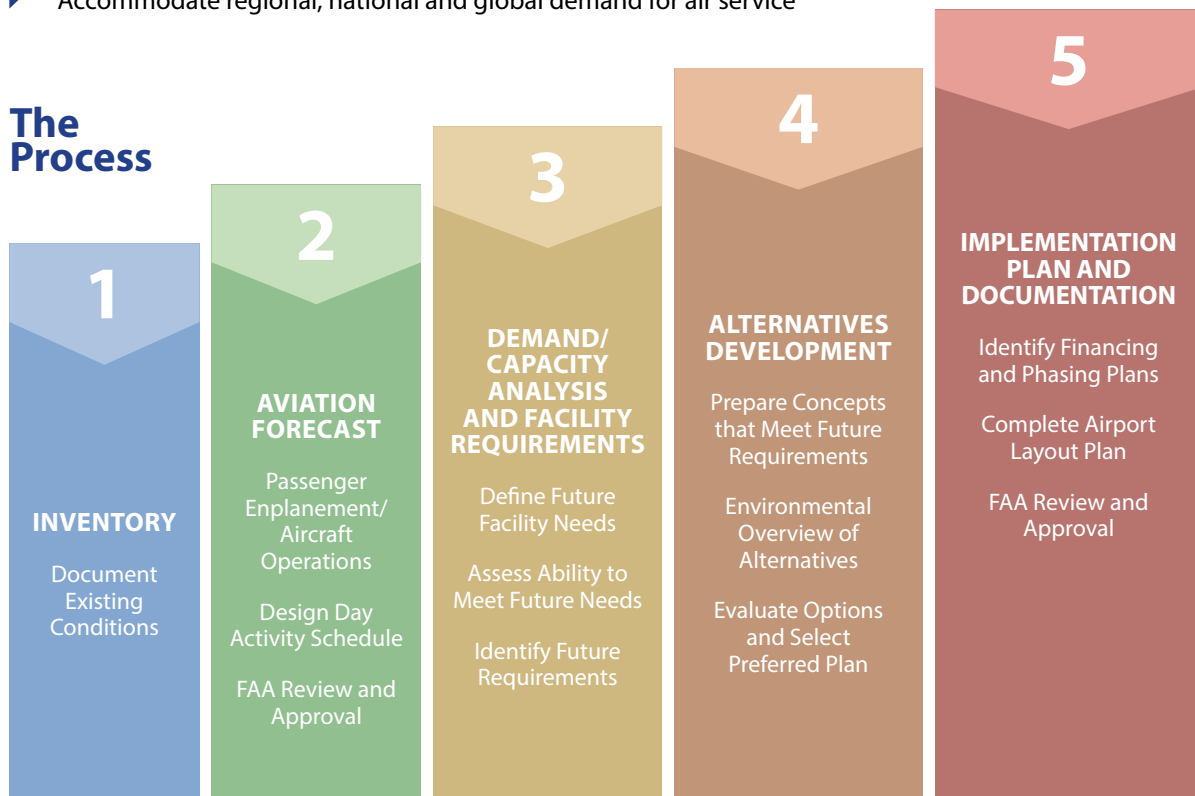


In June 2014, the Raleigh-Durham Airport Authority launched Vision2040, its master plan study that will chart the airport's development over the next 25 years. The purpose of the plan is to identify the airport's short, medium and long-term development to meet future aviation demand.

## Goals

- ▶ Guide future development at Raleigh-Durham International Airport through 2040
- ▶ Optimize airport infrastructure and resources in an operationally, financially and environmentally sustainable manner
- ▶ Provide flexibility and tools to respond to changes in aviation industry
- ▶ Accommodate regional, national and global demand for air service

## Financial Plan

A financial plan will be developed to demonstrate the airport's ability to fund the projects recommended in the master plan.

The plan will include the identification of potential funding sources, a financial feasibility analysis and phasing plans. It will also recommend opportunities to enhance revenues if current sources are determined insufficient to meet projected needs.

## Public Engagement

Public engagement is critical to the master plan process. Workshops will be held throughout the process to provide the public opportunities to learn about the project and provide input. Workshops will be held at major milestones in the project and are scheduled for:

- ▶ Workshop 2: Winter 2015-16
- ▶ Workshop 3: Spring 2016
- ▶ Workshop 4: Fall 2016
