- NO CHECKS! Cash, Credit Cards, & Money Orders ONLY**
- Tickets are Non-Refundable. Covered area for rain (Hurricanes rescheduled) No Exceptions!
- Tickets once purchased cannot be transferred to someone else without Mr. Peters' approval.
- There will be no re-entry to the dance, once a student leaves, they must exit the premises.
- All the rules outlined in the OCPS Student Code of Conduct apply, as this is a school function.
- You must show a picture ID and your ticket to enter the dance.
- Free Parking with ticket purchase.

We at Apopka High, take pride in the conduct of our students at school events. The following guidelines define appropriate behavior expectations of all Apopka students and their guests.

DRESS CODE

- Dresses/skirts must be mid-thigh in length or longer
- Dresses/skirts must be modest and completely cover all private areas
- No canes, chains, or baseball caps (fancy dress hats with an outfit are permitted)
- No undershirts are to be worn as shirts. No jeans, sport's jerseys, or t-shirts allowed.

ALCOHOL/DRUGS (ZERO TOLERANCE):

- Anyone perceived to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be referred to the police officer on duty, parents/guardians will be contacted and the disciplinary action of recommendation of expulsion will be administered.
- NO VAPES or JUULS permitted

DANCING:

- Student must remain in a standing position while dancing.
- Dancing may not be sexual in nature. No standing or dancing on tables or chairs.

REMOVAL FROM DANCE

- Students in violation of the above will be escorted from the premises. School officials will contact parents/guardians.
