Do you know how to Shelter In Place?

- Definition: the use of a structure and it's indoor atmosphere to temporarily separate individuals from a hazardous outdoor atmosphere.
- Some examples of when you might shelter in place:
 - Hazardous train derailment or highway accident with a hazardous chemical release
 - Tornado
 - Significant incident in the immediate area
- If an event occurs follow instructions from Local Management and First Responders. Listen to local news for updates.
- □ The PHL NDC Shelter In Place Locations are the second floor Men's and Woman's Locker Rooms. Use the stairs as the elevators will be shut down.
- □ Report to your respective Male or Female Locker Room. Please be prepared to stay quiet and pay attention to instructions. An employee head count will be conducted and must be correctly completed to ensure employee safety.
