

Childhood Cancer Kids Yoga Resources Requests Policy and FAQs

Is my child eligible?

We serve children who have cancer or are recovering from childhood cancer.

Do you serve siblings of medical children or surviving siblings?

We serve siblings of qualified medical children as well.

Is there an age limit?

The child or sibling must be 18 or younger on the date of the request.

Is there a cost for the yoga resources?

We provide yoga resources free of charge, regardless of financial need. We encourage families to use our services regardless of need because we are here to show that there are people who care about your child and family. If you do not have the financial need and are able to do so, we gratefully accept donations. Your donations help us to expand our services to more families.

Does the parent or guardian need to request the yoga resources?

We ask that a parent or guardian make the initial request.

How do you verify the child's eligibility?

We try to make it as easy as possible by asking for a Blog, CaringBridge or CarePages site, or Facebook page dedicated to the child. This method is ideal because we like to follow up with our kids. If you do not have a social media site you can confirm your child's eligibility with another nonprofit organization by providing a copy of your acceptance letter.

Do we need to provide a Medical Eligibility Form? Yes. Have your doctor complete a Medical Eligibility Form (to be sent via email).

Once eligibility has been confirmed, we will contact the parent by email using the address provided in the application. Because of the volume of requests we receive, we are unable to follow up with telephone calls and ask that you monitor your email, including your spam folder for a response from us.
