## Insurance adjuster test now available online

### TDI expects to add online exams for other licenses in 2021

Texans preparing to become licensed insurance adjusters can now take their final exams online.

The Texas Department of Insurance approved proposals by WebCE and the Adjuster School to offer online end-of-course exams. Individuals who complete the courses and pass the tests may apply to become state-licensed insurance adjusters.

Pearson VUE, which administers licensing exams for TDI, will add online options for other tests starting early next year. [TDI issues more than 30 types of licenses.](#)

Chris Herrick, who oversees TDI's agent licensing process, said maintaining the integrity of the tests is a priority in approving online options. Continuing education providers that want to offer online tests may contact TDI to schedule a demonstration of their testing platform, security measures, check-in process, and methods for monitoring students.

"Our priority is to work with providers that will ensure proper security and monitoring is in place," Herrick said.

Herrick also said that anyone taking an exam online must use a computer that meets technical requirements and have a quality web connection.
