DONATION APPLICATION

Instructions:

1. Please fill out all the information below. This information will provide the basis used in the consideration of the donation. The application may be filled out by an employee of the requesting organization but must be signed by an officer of the organization.
2. The organization making a request for a donation must be a non-profit company with a 501c3 or equivalent tax status.
3. The maximum award will not exceed \$250.
4. The purpose must be clearly defined, specific and measurable (e.g. 100 meals for the homeless). All donations will be restricted.
5. Preference will be for donations which have matching portions of cash. Work or services in kind will not be considered for matching donations.
6. Preference will be given to established and well known charitable organizations.
7. The decision will be based upon available Foundation funds.
