**CONTEST TIME:** 8:00 am

**CONTEST LOCATION:** Hutchinson Career Technical Education Academy Room T-201

**PURPOSE:** To test the knowledge of a team of contestants preparing for employment in the health occupations field and to recognize outstanding students for excellence and professionalism.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Team of four: Open to a team of four active SkillsUSA members currently enrolled in a program with a health career as the occupational objective.

**CLOTHING REQUIREMENT:** Official SkillsUSA Blazer, Black Jacket or SkillsUSA white polo shirt with black dress slacks (or black skirt for women), black socks and black leather shoes.

**CONTEST UPDATES:** Refer to the Technical Standards for guidelines.

Contestants must bring:

- 60 sheets of 8 ½ x 11 white blank paper
- 8 ½ x 11 blank colored paper for use as scrap paper
- Pens, Pencils, and black marking pens (four to six each)

## 2019 KANSAS STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS (KSC) CONTEST UPDATE



- All competitors must create a one-page resume and submit a hard copy to the technical committee chair at orientation. Failure to do so will result in a 10-point penalty.
- A basic calculator without memory functions

**NOTE:** No notes or reference materials of any kind will be permitted in the contest room.

This includes Mobile devices, cell phones, recording devices, and smart watches or other items deemed hazardous to the integrity of the contest are grounds for disqualification.

For the State Competition, the contest will consist of two rounds with 25 questions per round plus a written test.

**ROUNDS:** Each question is worth 16 points each. If a team answers a question correctly the team earns 16 points. If a team answers incorrectly the team will be deducted -10 points.

Categories of the rounds consist of:

- Health Maintenance
- Academic Foundations
- Safety Practices
- Employability Skills
- Legal Responsibility
- Teamwork
- Ethics
- Communication
- Systems
- Safety

**WRITTEN TEST:** Each member of the team will take a written test. The score will be tallied together then divided by 4 giving the team an average written test score for points earned for a team score.
