Ordinance No 736.

Being an ordinance calling a special election of the electors of the City of Garnett, Kansas, for submitting to them the question of voting bonds in the sum of Sixty Five Thousand \$65000.00 Dollars for the purpose of improving the electric lighting and water plant now owned and operated by said City and furnishing lights and power and water to the inhabitants of the City of Garnett, Kansas, and fixing the time and place of holding the special election.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF GARNETT, KANSAS:

Sec.1. That a special election be called and held in the City of Garnett, Kansas on the Fourth day of June, 1918, at the following places, to wit:

In the First Ward, in the building known as the Acuff building, situated on Lots 23 & 24, in Block 35.

In the Second Ward, in the building ^{known} as the Knights of Pythian Hall situated on Lots 22 & 23 in Block 34.

In the Third Ward, in the City Hall, situated on Lot 17, Block 47.

In the Fourth Ward, in the farmers room of the County Court House, in the City of Garnett, Kansas, for the purpose of submitting ~~the~~ to the qualified electors of the said City the proposition to issue bonds

of the said City in the sum of Sixty Five Thousand (\$65000.00) Dollars for the purpose of improving the electric lighting and water plant now owned and operated by said city and furnishing electric lights, power and water to the inhabitants within the limits of the said city. The bonds shall be payable in not more than thirty (30) years from their date and shall be issued in denominations not exceeding One-Thousand (\$1000.00) Dollars nor less than One-hundred (\$100.00) Dollars

Sec.2. The voting places of said election shall be as stated in Section 1. of this Ordinance, in said city of Garnett, Kansas. The polls at said election shall be open from 8 o'clock A.M. to 6 o'clock P.M. of the said Fourth day of June, 1918.

Sec.3. The ballot used in the said election shall be substantially in the following form, to wit:

To vote in favor of any question submitted upon this ballot, make a cross X in the square after the word YES; to vote against it make a similar mark in the square after the word NO.

Shall the following be adopted?

Proposition to issue bonds in the city of Garnett, Kansas, to the amount of Sixty Five Thousand \$65000.00 Dollars with interest not to exceed Five % per annum and payable in not more than thirty years for the purpose of improving the electric lighting ^{and water} plant and furnishing electric light ^{and water} and power to the inhabitants of said city.
